

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Heartland® Filet Crochet Shawl

Pattern Number: L40668



SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZES

Finished Width 50 in. (127 cm), across top edge Finished Length 25 in. (63.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 144 Kenai Fjords 2 balls
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

14 dc + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows beg at center top.
- 2. Markers are placed and increases are worked at markers to shape the Shawl.
- 3. An edging is worked around the outer edge of Shawl.

SHAWL

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Row 1 into the ring.

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), dc in ring, (ch 1, dc in ring) 3 times – you will have 5 dc and 4 ch-1 sps. Gently but firmly, pull yarn tail to tighten center of ring.

Row 2: Ch 4, turn, dc in first dc, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 9 dc and 8 ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 13 dc and 12 ch-1 sps.

Row 4: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc; rep from * twice, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 17 dc and 16 ch-1 sps.

Row 5: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 1, sk next ch-1

sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc; rep from * twice, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 21 dc and 20 ch-1 sps.

Row 6: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, place a marker in last dc made, *(ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, place a marker in last dc made; rep from * twice, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 25 dc and 24 ch-1 sps.

Rows 7-10: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to ch-sp before next marked dc, ch 1, sk next ch-sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in marked dc, move marker to last dc made; rep from * 3 times, (ch 1, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, dc in turning ch-sp – 41 dc and 40 ch-1 sps at the end of Row 10.

Rows 11-14: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), turn, sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 2, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to ch-sp before next marked dc, ch 2, sk next ch-sp, dc in marked dc, move marker to last dc made; rep from * 3 times, (ch 2, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 2, dc in turning ch-sp – 41 dc and 40 ch-2 sps.

Rows 15 and 16: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), turn, sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 2, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to ch-sp before next marked dc, ch 2, sk next ch-sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in marked dc, move marker to last dc made; rep from * 3 times, (ch 2, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 2, dc in turning ch-sp – 49 dc and 48 ch-2 sps at the end of Row 16.

Rows 17 and 18: Rep Row 11 twice.

Rows 19 and 20: Rep Rows 15 and 16 – 57 dc and 56 ch-2 sps at the end of Row 20.

Rows 21-24: Ch 6 (counts as first dc, ch 3), turn, sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to ch-sp before next marked dc, ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in marked dc, move marker to last dc made; rep from * 3 times, (ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 3, dc in turning ch-sp – 57 dc and 56 ch-3 sps.

Rows 25 and 26: Ch 6 (counts as first dc, ch 3), turn, sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *(ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to ch-sp before next marked dc, ch 3, sk next ch-sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in marked dc, move marker to last dc made; rep from * 3 times, (ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc) to turning ch-sp, ch 3, dc in turning ch-sp – 65 dc and 64 ch-3 sps at the end of Row 26. Remove markers.

Rows 27-30: Ch 6 (counts as first dc, ch 3), turn, sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *ch 3, sk next ch-sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 3, dc in turning ch-sp - 65 dc and 64 ch-3 sps.

Row 31: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, 3 dc in first ch-sp, dc in next dc, *3 dc in next ch-sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, 4 dc in turning ch-sp – 257 dc.

Row 32: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), turn, sk first 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next dc, dc in next dc, *(ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * to 2 dc before turning ch, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in top of turning ch – 97 dc and 96 ch-2 sps.

Row 33: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, *2 dc in next ch-sp, dc in next dc, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times; rep from * to turning ch-sp, 3 dc in turning ch-sp – 137 dc and 76 ch-2 sps.

Row 34: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), turn, sk first 3 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times, *ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times; rep from * to 2 dc before turning ch, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in top of turning ch – 97 dc and 96 ch-2 sps.

Row 35: Rep Row 33.

Row 36: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next ch-sp, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, 2 dc in next ch-sp, *dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next ch-sp, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, 2 dc in next ch-sp; rep from * to 3 dc before turning ch, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of turning ch – 209 dc and 38 ch-2 sps.

Row 37: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in next 6 dc, *(2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc) twice, dc in next 9 dc; rep from * to turning ch, dc in top of turning ch – 289 dc.

Do not fasten off.

Edging

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to turning ch, 3 sc in turning ch-sp; work 2 sc in the end of each row all the way across top edge, 2 sc in corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
