#### SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate+

## <u>SIZES</u>

S/M (L/1X, 2X/3X) **Finished Bust** 36 (46, 56) in. (91.5 (117, 142) cm) **Finished Length** 13 (14 1/2, 16 1/2) in. (33 (37, 42) cm) at center back, not including edging

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 389 Isle Royale Tweed 2 (3, 4) balls
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# <u>GAUGE</u>



2 pattern reps + 8 1/2 rows = about 5 in. (12.5 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep consists of (3 tr, ch 2, 3 sc, ch 2) or (3 dc, ch 2, 3 sc, ch 2). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# STITCH EXPLANATIONS

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**tr2tog (tr 2 sts together)** (Yarn over) twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice. (Yarn over) twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, (yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

# **NOTES**

- 1. Bolero is made in 3 pieces: Back and 2 Fronts. The 2 Fronts are worked the same and the pattern stitch is reversible. When you put the Bolero together, simply flip one Front over so that it is the mirror image of the other Front.
- 2. Edgings are worked around armholes and outer edge of assembled Bolero.

3. When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that you should not perform that particular instruction, just skip to the next part of the instruction.

#### **BACK**

Beg at lower edge, ch 65 (81, 97).

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), dc in next 3 ch, \*ch 2, sk next ch, sc in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next 3 ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, dc in last 2 ch – you will have 49 (61, 73) sts and 14 (18, 22) ch-2 sps at the end of this row (for 7 (9, 11) pattern reps).

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 5 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in next 4 sts, sc in top of beg ch.

**Row 3 (Decrease Row):** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, tr in each st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in each st to last 2 sts, tr2tog – 47 (59, 71) sts and 14 (18, 22) ch-2 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in each st to turning ch, leave turning ch unworked.

**Rows 5-8:** Rep Rows 3 and 4 twice – 43 (55, 67) sts and 14 (18, 22) ch-2 sps at the end of Row 7 (for 7 (9, 11) pattern reps).

**Row 9:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next st, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in last 2 sts.

# Size S/M Only

Proceed to "Shape Armholes".

#### Sizes L/1X (2X/3X) Only

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in last 2 sts. **Row 11:** Rep Row 9.

Rep Rows 10 and 11 for 0 (1) time(s) more.

#### Shape Armholes

**Row 1 (WS):** Turn, sl st in first 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in next st; leave turning ch unworked – 40 (52, 64) sts and 13 (17, 21) ch-2 sps.

**Rows 2-3 (4, 5):** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 ch-2 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next st; leave rem sts

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unworked -28 (34, 40) sts (not counting sl sts) and 9 (11, 13) ch-2 sps at the end of Row 3 (4, 5).

**Row 4 (5, 6):** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp; leave last ch-2 sp unworked -27 (33, 39) sts and 8 (10, 12) ch-2 sps.

Row 5 (6, 7): Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* across.

**Row 6 (7, 8):** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch. **Next 6 Rows:** Rep last 2 rows 3 times.

Last Row: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, \*ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across. Fasten off.

#### FRONTS (make 2)

Beg at lower edge, ch 10 (18, 26).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, (ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk next ch, sc in next 3 ch) 0 (1, 2) time(s), ch 2, sk next ch, dc in last 5 ch – you will have 8 (14, 20) sts and 1 (3, 5) ch-2 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 5 sts, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts) 0 (1, 2) time(s), ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, (tr, ch 2, dc) in last st -9 (15, 21) sts and 2 (4, 6) ch-2 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 9, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, ch 2, sk next 2 ch, tr in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts) 0 (1, 2) time(s), ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, tr2tog - 13 (19, 25) sts and 3 (5, 7) ch-2 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sts, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts) 1 (2, 3) time(s), ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, (tr, ch 2, dc) in last st - 14 (20, 26) sts and 4 (6, 8) ch-2 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 9, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, ch 2, sk next 2 ch, tr in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, (ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts) 1 (2, 3) time(s), ch 2, sk last ch-

2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, tr2tog – 18 (24, 30) sts and 5 (7, 9) ch-2 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, (tr, ch 2, dc) in last st - 19 (25, 31) sts and 6 (8, 10) ch-2 sps.

**Row 7:** Ch 6, place marker in the 3rd ch of the ch-6 just made for front corner, turn, tr in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as first tr), tr in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in next st, tr2tog – 20 (26, 32) sts and 6 (8, 10) ch-2 sps.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to first ch-2 sp, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across working last sc in top of turning ch.

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**Row 9:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in last 2 sts. **Next 0 (2, 4) Rows:** Rep Rows 8 and 9 for 0 (1, 2) times.

#### Shape Armhole and Neck

**Row 1:** Turn, sl st in first 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 18 (24, 30) sts (not counting sl sts) and 6 (8, 10) ch-2 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr) turn, tr in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 ch-2 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 16 (22, 28) sts and 4 (6, 8) ch-2 sps.

#### Size S/M Only

**Row 3:** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st, sc2tog (worked over next st and top of turning ch) – 11 sts (not counting sl sts) and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, tr in next st, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked – 10 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st; leave turning ch unworked – 10 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (working over first sc and next ch-2 sp), ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 10 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 7:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, tr2tog (working over next 2 sts, skipping the ch-1 sp between them) – 9 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 8:** Turn, sl st in first st, ch 1, sc2tog, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 7 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 9:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in last st – 7 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st and ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 6 sts and 1 ch-2 sp.

**Row 11:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts – 6 sts and 1 ch-2 sp.

**Row 12:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 6 sts and 1 ch-2 sp.

**Row 13:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 6 sts and 1 ch-1 sp. Fasten off.

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#### Size L/1X Only

**Row 3:** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 18 sts (not counting sl sts) and 6 ch-2 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 ch-2 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 16 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next tr, sc2tog (working over next st and top of turning ch) – 14 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, tr in next st, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* across – 13 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st; leave turning ch unworked – 13 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (working over first sc and next ch-2 sp), ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in last 3 sts – 13 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, tr2tog (working over next 2 sts skipping the ch-1 sp between them) – 12 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 10:** Turn, sl st in first st, ch 1, sc2tog, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts – 10 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in last st – 10 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st and ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts – 9 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in last 3 sts – 9 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Row 14:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in last 3 sts – 9 sts and 2 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

#### Size 2X/3X Only

**Row 3:** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 24 sts (not counting sl sts) and 8 ch-2 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 ch-2 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 22 sts and 6 ch-2 sps.

**Row 5:** Turn, sk first st, sl st in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in next tr, sc2tog (working over next st and top of turning ch) – 17 sts and 6 ch-2 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, tr in next st, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 ch-2 sps, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked – 16 sts and 5 ch-2 sps.

**Row 7:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, sk first st, tr in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in next st; leave turning ch unworked – 16 sts and 5 ch-2 sps.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (working over first sc and next ch-2 sp), ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across working last sc in top of turning ch – 16 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 9:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 2 sts, tr2tog (working over next 2 sts skipping the ch-1 sp between them) – 15 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 10:** Turn, sl st in first st, ch 1, sc2tog, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 13 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 11:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, tr in last st - 13 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st and ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 12 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 13:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in last 3 sts – 12 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 14:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, tr in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 sts, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 12 sts and 3 ch-2 sps.

**Row 15:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 12 sts and 3 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder and side seams. Armhole Edging

From RS, join yarn with sl st at side seam of armhole. **Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 72 (80, 88) sc as evenly spaced as possible a

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 72 (80, 88) sc as evenly spaced as possible around armhole edge; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Rep around other armhole.

## Outer Edging

From RS, join yarn with sl st in first st of back neck.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, work 24 sc spaced as evenly as possible across back neck, work 48 (54, 60) sc spaced as evenly as possible across edge to marker at front corner, 3 sc in marked sp, move marker to center sc of the 3-sc group just made, work 107 (143, 179) sc spaced as evenly as possible across edge to next front corner marker, 3 sc in marked sp, move marker to center sc of the 3-sc group just made, work 48 (54, 60) sc spaced as evenly as possible across edge to beg of rnd; join with sl st in first sc – 234 (282, 330) sc. **Rnd 2:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), 6 tr in same st as joining, (sk next 3 sts, sc in next st, \*sk next 2 sts, 7 tr in next st, sk next 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from \* to 3 sts before first marker, sk next 3 sts, 11 tr in marked st) twice, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st, \*\*sk next 2 sts, 7 tr in next st, sk next 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from \*\* to last 3 sts, sk last 3 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

## Ties (work 2)

From RS, join yarn with sl st in marked front corner, ch 72. Fasten off. Rep on opposite front corner. Weave in ends.
