Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand[®] Scarfie Duo Tone Throw

*Scarfie (Article #826). 78% acrylic, 22% wool; package

size: 5.30oz/150.00 gr. (312yds/285m) pull skeins

Pattern Number: L50112B

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

MATERIALS

- 826-201 <u>Lion Brand Scarfie:</u> <u>Cream/Black</u> 5 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook -Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

13 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

5 Strips are crocheted then sewn together to make Throw.

STRIP (make 5)

Ch 28.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (first 2 skipped ch do not count as an hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 26 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as an hdc), turn, hdc in each stitch across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 56 in. (142 cm) from beginning. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew long sides of Strips together to make Throw. Weave in ends.
