SKILL LEVEL - Experienced

SIZES

S (M-L, 1X-2X)

Finished Bust 36 (44, 52) in. (91.5 (112, 132) cm)

Finished Waist 32 (40, 48) in. (81.5 (101.5, 122) cm)

Finished Hip 38 (46, 54) in. (96.5 (117, 137) cm)

Finished Length 35 (37, 38) in. (89 (94, 96.5) cm), including lower ribbing, not including turtleneck

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease (Art. #620)
 - 139 Dark Rose Heather 6 (8, 9) balls (A)
 - 152 Oxford Grey 3 (4, 5) balls (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour (Art. #861)
 - 153 Onyx 5 (6, 7) balls (C)
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size P-15 (11.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

8 sts = 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) and 4 rows = 4 in. (11.5 cm) in Bobble pattern with largest hook and 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Bobble With 3 strands of yarn held tog, yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook). (Yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop – 2 additional loops on hook) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1. **Note:** The ch 1 does not count as a st. To work into a Bobble, work into the loop at the top of the Bobble, do not work into the ch-1.

One-strand Bobble With only 1 strand of indicated color, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook). (Yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and

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draw up a loop – 2 additional loops on hook) 7 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook; with all 3 strands held tog, ch 1. **Note:** The ch 1 does not count as a st. To work into a One-strand Bobble, work into the loop at the top of the Bobble, do not work into the ch-1.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

BOBBLE COLOR SEQUENCE

*Work next One-strand Bobble with C, next One-strand Bobble with B, next One-Strand Bobble with A; rep from * as needed.

NOTES

1. Dress is worked in 4 pieces; Front, Back, and 2 Sleeves.
2. Turtleneck is worked around neck edge after pieces are assembled.
3. Ribbing is worked with 1 strand of A only. Body of Front, Back and Sleeves are worked with 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog throughout.
4. All Bobbles are worked on RS rows. WS rows are worked in dc only.
5. Work Bobbles and dc sts with 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog. Work One-strand Bobbles, with 1 strand of the indicated color only, to the final ch-1. Work the final ch-1 with 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog.
6. Work loosely.

BACK

Ribbing

With smallest hook and 1 strand of A, ch 33.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as first hdc) and in each ch across – 32 hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-55 (67, 79): Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Body

Notes:

1. First row of body is worked across one long edge of ribbing.
2. Work the One-strand Bobbles, beg with indicated color, following the Bobble Color Sequence or Chart. Work the dc sts between the Bobbles with 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog.

From RS with largest hook and 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog, join yarn with sl st in end of first row of ribbing, to work across one long edge.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in end of same row of ribbing, *sk end of next row, sc in end of next row; rep from * across long edge of ribbing – 28 (34, 40) sc at the end of this row.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, dc in each sc across.

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Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across. **Note:** Take care to work into the loop at the top of each Bobble, but not into the ch-1 that closes the Bobble.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Shape Sides

Row 8 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3 (counts as dc with base in same st as sl st just made), dc in each st across to last st; leave last st unworked – 26 (32, 38) dc at the end of this row.

Row 9: Ch 3, turn, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 12 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 24 (30, 36) dc at the end of this row.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 14: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, Bobble in next dc, dc in last dc.

Row 16: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 17: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 18 (Increase Row): Ch 3, turn, dc in first st (increase made), dc in each st across to last st, 2 dc in last st – 26 (32, 38) dc.

Row 19: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 20: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Row 21: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, Bobble in next dc, dc in last dc.

Place a marker at beg and end of Row 21 for raglan seams.

Row 22 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 24 (30, 36) dc at the end of this row.

Row 23 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 3 dc, One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next dc; leave last dc unworked – 22 (28, 34) sts at the end of this row.

Row 24 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 20 (26, 32) dc at the end of this row.

Row 25 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, dc in next dc; leave last dc unworked – 18 (24, 30) sts at the end of this row.

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Row 26 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 16 (22, 28) dc at the end of this row.

Sizes M-L ONLY

Row 27 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, dc in next dc; leave last dc unworked - 20 dc at the end of this row.

Row 28 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in each dc across to last 2 dc; leave last 2 dc unworked – 16 dc at the end of this row.

Size 1X-2X ONLY

Row 27 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc; leave last 2 dc unworked – 24 dc at the end of this row.

Rows 28 and 29 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in each dc across to last 2 dc; leave last 2 dc unworked – 16 dc at the end of Row 29.

ALL SIZES

Row 27 (29, 30): Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, hdc in next dc, sc in next 10 dc, hdc in next dc, dc in last 2 dc.

Fasten off.

FRONT

Make same as Back.

SLEEVE (make 2)

Cuff

With smallest hook and 1 strand of A, ch 17.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as first hdc) and in each ch across – 16 hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-16: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sleeve

1. First row of Sleeve is worked across long edge of ribbing.
2. Work the One-strand Bobbles, beg with indicated color, following the Bobble Color Sequence or Chart. Work the dc sts between the Bobbles with 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog.

From RS with largest hook and 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog, join yarn with sl st in end of first row of ribbing, to work across one long edge.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in end of each row across – 16 sc at the end of this row.

Size S ONLY

Row 2 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in first dc (increase made), *dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next sc; rep from * across – 22 dc at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 8 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in each st across to last st; leave last st unworked – 20 dc at the end of this row.

Row 9: Ch 3, turn, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 12 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 18 dc at the end of this row.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 14 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 16 dc at the end of this row.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Shape Raglan Armhole

Place a marker at beg and end of Row 15 for raglan seams.

Row 16 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 14 dc at the end of this row.

Row 17: Ch 3, turn, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 18 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 12 dc at the end of this row.

Row 19: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 20 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 10 dc at the end of this row.

Size M-L ONLY

Row 2 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in first dc (increase made), *dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next sc; rep from * across – 22 dc at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

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Row 7: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 8 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in each st across to last st; leave last st unworked – 20 dc at the end of this row.

Row 9: Ch 3, turn, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 12: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 14: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Shape Raglan Armhole

Place a marker at beg and end of Row 15 for raglan seams.

Row 16 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 18 dc at the end of this row.

Row 17: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 18 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 16 dc at the end of this row.

Row 19: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc.

Row 20 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 14 dc at the end of this row.

Row 21 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last dc; leave last dc unworked – 12 dc at the end of this row.

Row 22 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc across to last dc; leave last dc unworked – 10 dc at the end of this row.

Size 1X-2X ONLY

Row 2 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in first dc (increase made), *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc – 24 dc at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in last dc.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with C, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 8 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in each st across to last st; leave last st unworked – 22 dc at the end of this row.

Row 9: Ch 3, turn, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

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Row 11: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with A, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in last dc.

Row 12: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 14: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 2 dc, Bobble in next dc, dc in last dc.

Shape Raglan Armhole

Place a marker at beg and end of Row 15 for raglan seams.

Row 16 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 20 dc at the end of this row.

Row 17: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 18 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 18 dc at the end of this row.

Row 19: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, beg with B, *One-strand Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across.

Row 20 (Decrease Row): Rep Row 8 – 16 dc at the end of this row.

Row 21 (Decrease Row): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *Bobble in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * across to last 3 dc, Bobble in next dc, dc in next dc; leave last dc unworked – 14 dc at the end of this row.

Rows 22 and 23 (Decrease Rows): Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc across to last dc; leave last dc unworked – 10 dc at the end of Row 23.

ALL SIZES

Row 21 (23, 24): Turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in next dc, hdc in next dc, sc in next 2 dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; leave last dc unworked – 8 sts at the end of this row.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Note: Use 1 strand of B to sew pieces tog.

Sew Sleeves to Front and Back along raglan edges, from markers up to top edge. Sew side and underarm seams. With yarn tails, sew edges of all ribbing together.

Turtleneck

From RS, with largest hook and 1 strand each of A, B, and C held tog, join yarn with sl st in center back neck.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog) 12 times; join with sl st in first sc – 36 sc at the end of this rnd.

Fasten off.

From RS, with middle-sized hook and 2 strands of A held tog, join yarn with sl st in first sc of Rnd 2.

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Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog, sc in next 16 sc, sc2tog, sc in last 8; join with sl st in first sc – 34 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Ribbed Turtleneck

Notes:

1. The neck ribbing is worked in rows at right-angles to the neck edge.
2. The ribbing is joined to Rnd 4 of the Dress at the end of every other row.
3. The ribbing is worked in sts of the previous row of ribbing, and sl sts are worked into Rnd 4 of the neck edge of the Dress ONLY at the end of every other ribbing row.
4. If desired, ribbing can be worked separately and then sewn to Rnd 4 of the Dress. If making a separate turtleneck, fasten off Dress after Rnd 4.
To work ribbed turtleneck separately, work as follows:
Row 1: Ch 33, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in next 30 ch.
Rows 2-51: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn tail, sew ends of ribbing tog. Sew ribbed turtleneck around neck edge of dress.

Cut 1 strand of A, continue with middle-sized hook and 1 strand of A only.

Row 1: Ch 33, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in next 30 ch, sl st in first sc of Rnd 4 (at base of ch 33).

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Row 3: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across, sl st in next 2 sc of Rnd 4.

Row 4: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Row 5: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across, sl st in same sc of Rnd 4 (same sc as last sl st worked), sl st in next sc of Rnd 4.

Rep Rows 2-5 until all sts of Rnd 4 have been worked into.

Next Row: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Last Row: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across, sl st in first sc of Rnd 4 (same sc as in Row 1 of ribbing).

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With tail, sew edges of ribbing tog.

Weave in ends.
