 635-109 <u>Lion Brand Wool-</u> <u>Ease Tonal: Royal Blue</u>
 1 Ball (A)

• 635-108 <u>Lion Brand Wool-</u> Ease Tonal: <u>Lapis</u>

1 Ball (B)

• 635-110 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Denim</u>

1 Ball (C)

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u> <u>Size N-13 (9 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>
 <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

7 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Cowl is worked in one piece in joined and turned rounds.
- 2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the stitch. Fasten off old color.

COWL

With A, ch 74.

Join with sl st in first ch to make a ring, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each ch around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 74 dc at the end of Rnd 1.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-sp), turn, *sk next st, dc in next st, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch - 37 dc and 37 ch-sp.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each dc and ch-sp around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 74 dc.

Rnds 4-7: Rep Rnds 2 and 3 twice.

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 2, changing to B in last st.

Rnd 9: With B, rep Rnd 3.

Rnds 10-15: With B, rep Rnds 2 and 3 three times. Rnd 16: With B, rep Rnd 2, changing to C in last st.

Rnds 17-24: With C, rep Rnds 9-16.

st(s) = stitch(es)

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
