

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand[®] Nature's Choice Organic[®] Cotton V-Shawl Pattern Number: 80442C



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<u>SKILL LEVEL –</u> Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

About 14 x 72 in. (35.5 x 183 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Nature's Choice Organic® Cotton (Art. #480)
 - 206 Wildflowers 6 balls
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

14 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

kfb (knit into front and then back)

An increase worked as follows:

1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.

2. Knit the same st once more, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
 3. Drop the st from your left hand needle – you have increased 1 st.

NOTES

- 1. In First Half, stitches are increased at the beg and decreased at the end of every other row, to form diagonal edges of one leg of V.
- 2. In Second Half, the increases and decreases are worked on the opposite edges, to form diagonal edges of other leg of V.
- 3. Stitch markers are used to keep track of which edge is the increase edge and which the decrease edge.

<u>SHAWL</u>

First Half

Cast on 48 sts.

Row 1: SI 1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Place a marker at beg of Row 1 for increase edge. Place a different color marker at end of Row 1 for decrease edge.



Row 2: SI 1, k to end of row. Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 36 in. (91.5 cm) along diagonal edge, ending with a Row 1. Remove markers

Second Half

Rows 1 and 2: Rep Rows 1 and 2 of First Half.
Place a marker at beg of Row 2 for decrease edge. Place a different color marker at end of Row 2 for increase edge.
Row 3: Rep Row 1 of First Half.
Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Second Half measures same as First Half. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)(s) k = knit k2tog = knit 2 together rep = repeat sl = slip st(s) = stitch(es)
