

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Hometown USA®-Fun Fur Classic Cabled Headband

Pattern Number: L0728C



SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

<u>SIZE</u>

About 4 1/2 x 19 in. (11.5 x 48.5 cm)

Note: Headband will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
 - 146 New Orleans French Berry1 ball (A)
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® Fun Fur (Art. #320)
 - 143 Orchid 1 ball (B)
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® cable needle
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Sewing needle and thread Fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over cable pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

KNIT STITCH EXPLANATION

4/4 LC (4 over 4 left cross) Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k4, then k4 from cable needle.

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: P the knit sts, and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTE

When you see 'as established' in the instructions, this means to continue in the current pattern st.



HEADBAND

With knitting needles and A, cast on 14 sts.

Work in Seed st for 2 rows.

Beg Cable Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Work in Seed st as established over 2 sts, p1, k8, p1, work in Seed st as established over last 2 sts.

Row 2: Work in Seed st as established over 2 sts, k1, p8, k1, work in Seed st as established over last 2 sts.

Rows 3-6: Rep last 2 rows twice.

Row 7 (RS): Work in Seed st as established over 2 sts, p1, 4/4 LC, p1, work in Seed st as established over last 2 sts.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Rows 9-16: Rep Rows 1 and 2 four times.

Rep Rows 1-16 until piece measures about 18 1/2 in. (47 cm) from beg, end with a WS row. **Note:** End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row.

Work in Seed st for 2 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Overlap ends of Headband and pin together. Try on Headband and adjust to fit comfortably. With sewing needle and thread, seam lapped ends in place.

POUF

With smaller needles and B, cast on 24 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every st of every row) until piece measures about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) from beg. Bind off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then sew large running sts around outside edge of piece. Stuff, then draw edges together adding additional stuffing if needed to create a rounded sphere. Knot yarn tail tightly, then with same tail, sew Pouf to Headband.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
