

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Fettuccini® Easy Crochet Trivet Pattern Number: L20005



SKILL LEVEL - Beginner

SIZES

Small Trivet

Finished Diameter: About 5 1/2 in. (14 cm)

Large Trivet

Finished Diameter: About 8 1/2 in. (22 cm)

MATERIALS

 Lion Brand® Fettuccini® (Art. #752)

- 1 cone in the color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook Q-19 (15 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch marker

GAUGE

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL TO THIS PROJECT.

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STITCH EXPLANATION

Adjustable ring method: Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop, then chain 1. Carefully slip ring from finger and work stitches of first round into ring. When first round is complete, gently, but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring

SMALL TRIVET

Make an adjustable ring, then work 6 single crochet into center of ring. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join.

Place marker for beginning of round, move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 1: Chain 1, work 2 single crochet in each stitch around – 12 stitches at the end of this round. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join.

Round 2: Chain 1, single crochet in each stitch around. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join.

Round 3: Chain 1, *single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet in next stitch; repeat from * around – 18 stitches at the end of this round. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join. Fasten off.

LARGE TRIVET

Make an adjustable ring, then work 6 single crochet into center of ring. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join.

Place marker for beginning of round, move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 1-3: Work as for Small Trivet. Do not fasten off.

Round 4: Repeat Round 2

Round 5: Chain 1, *single crochet in each of next 2 stitches, 2 single crochet in next stitch; repeat from * around – 24 stitches at the end of this round. Slip stitch in first single crochet to join. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Tuck yarn ends into crochet stitches.
