



Free Knitting Pattern
Lion Brand® Amazing®
Mistake Rib Scarf
Pattern Number: L20134B



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 9 x 70 in. (23 x 178 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Amazing® (Art. #825)
 - 203 Wildflowers 5 balls
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

About 14 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to match the gauge, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES

1. Scarf is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.
2. Wind one ball of yarn into two separate balls before beginning.
3. The “mistake” is that the rib pattern begins differently on each row.

SCARF

With 2 strands of yarn held together, cast on 31 sts.

Row 1: K3, *p1, k3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k3; rep from * across to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until about 2 yds (2 m) of yarn remain. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
