

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Vanna's Choice<sup>®</sup> Striped iPad Cover Pattern Number: L20113



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## SKILL LEVEL – Easy

## <u>SIZE</u>

About 7 1/2 x 10 in. (19 x 25.5 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 109 Colonial Blue 1 ball (A)
  - 102 Aqua 1 ball (B)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# ADDITIONAL MATERIALS



3 1/2 in. (9 cm) length of 5/8 in. (1.5 cm) wide hook and loop tape Sewing needle and thread

# <u>GAUGE</u>

 $\overline{19 \text{ sts} + 26 \text{ rows}} = 4 \text{ in.} (10 \text{ cm}) \text{ in St st } (k \text{ on RS, p on WS}).$ 

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. (10 cm) square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Cover is worked in one piece, then folded in half and sides are seamed.
- 2. Color is changed to work stripes across front of Cover. Carry color not in use alongside edge, strands will be concealed in side seams.

# <u>COVER</u>

Front Beg at top edge, with A, cast on 36 sts. Rows 1 and 2: Knit. Change to B. Row 3 (RS): With B, knit. Continue in St st (k on RS, p on WS) changing color as follows: Row 4: With B. Rows 5-8: With A. Rows 9 and 10: With B. Rep Rows 5-10 nine times. Fasten off B. Work 2 more rows with A.

#### Bag Back

Continue with A, work in St st until back measures same length as front, end with a RS row. **Note:** End with a RS row means that the last row you work should be a RS row. Knit 2 rows. **Tab Row 1:** Bind off 9 sts, knit to end of row – 27 sts. **Row 2:** Bind off 9 sts, knit to end of row – 18 sts.

Knit 14 rows. Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Fold Cover, bringing front cast-on edge up to meet bound-off edges at beg of tab, sew side seams. Sew one half of hook and loop tape to underside of tab. Sew other half of tape to front of Cover, aligning it with tape on tab. Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = beginning
k = knit
p = purl
rep = repeat(ing)
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
St st = Stockinette stitch
WS = wrong side
