

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Hometown USA® The Future Is Bright Scarf Pattern Number: L20395



<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

SIZE

About 10 x 66 in. (25.5 x 167.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
 - 153 Oakland Black 3 balls (A)
 - 400 Neon Pink 1 ball (B)
 - 401 Neon Orange 1 ball (C)
 - 402 Neon Lemon 1 ball (D)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Binder clips

GAUGE

11 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to match the gauge, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES

- 30 individual strips are worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS), then woven together to make the Scarf.
- 2. Edges of Strips will naturally curl slightly.

BLACK STRIPS (make 4)

With A, cast on 7 sts.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 66 in. (167.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

NEON STRIPS (make 26 – 9 each with B and C, and 8 with D)

Cast on 7 sts.

Work in St st until piece measures 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg. Bind off.

FINISHING

Neon Strip Sequence

Weave strips in the following order *B, C, D; rep from *, ending last rep with a C Strip.

Note: To weave the strips together, you will need a large, flat surface on which to work.

Weaving

Lay Black Strips side by side with long edges together and with RS of strips facing. Beg at one end of the Black Strips, weave a B Neon Strip across the Black Strips weaving as follows:

Row 1: Weave the B Neon Strip under the first Black Strip, over the second Black Strip under the third Black Strip then over the last Black Strip.

With binder clips, clip ends of Black Strips to B Neon Strip, at each end and along the short side of the Scarf.

Row 2: Directly above the B Strip, weave a C Neon Strip over the first Black Strip, under the second Black Strip, over the next Black Strip and under the last Black Strip.

Clip the ends of the C Neon Strip to the Black Strips on either side.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 continuing to change colors following Neon Strip Sequence, until all strips have been woven, clipping the ends of each Neon Strip as you work.

When all strips have been woven, with matching color yarn and from RS, remove one binder clip at a time and sew strips together along both ends and both sides of Scarf with a few sts. With matching color yarn, sew a few sts through each intersection of strips. Weave in ends.

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette st

WS = wrong side
