

Free Knit-Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®Vanna's Glamour®-Homespun®Thick & Quick®-Vanna's Choice®-Amazing® Nepolitan Ripple Throw

Pattern Number: L32300



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 46 x 60 in. (117 x 152.5 cm), at longest and widest points and not including fringe

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Art. #640)
 - 308 Starlight 3 balls (A)
 - 098 Linen 2 balls (B)
 - 304 Gemstone 1 ball (C)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour® (Art. #861)
 - 170 Topaz 1 ball (D)
 - 149 Moonstone 1 ball (E)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Art. #792)
 - 201 Coral Stripes 1 skein (F)
 - 312 Edwardian 1 skein (G)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 405 Silver Heather 1 ball (H)
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® Amazing® (Art. #825)
 - 216 Cobblestone 1 ball (I)
 - 207 Pink Sands 1 ball (J)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 17 (13 mm), 40 in. (101.5 cm) long

GAUGE

One Zigzag = about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) measured from peak to peak.

11 rows = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) in Zigzag pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



STITCH EXPLANATIONS

sl2kp (slip 2-k1-pass slipped sts over)

A double decrease worked as follows:

- 1. Insert right needle into next 2 sts as if to knit them tog, and slip them from the left needle to the right needle.
- 2. Knit the next st.
- 3. With tip of left needle, lift the 2 slipped sts (the 2nd and 3rd sts on the right needle) up and over the knit st (first st on right needle) and off the needle you have decreased 2 sts.

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCH

Zigzag Pattern (multiple of 16 sts + 1 additional st)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *yo, k6, sl2kp, k6, yo, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Zigzag pattern.

NOTES

- 1. Throw is worked in Zigzag pattern with 1, 2, or 3 strands of yarn held tog.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 3. When changing colors, cut old colors, do not carry them across work.
- 4. Fringes are added to each peak and valley of the zigzags across cast-on and bound-off edges of Throw.

THROW

With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, cast on 97 sts.

Working back and forth on circular needle, as if working on straight needles, knit 3 rows.

Begin Zigzag Pattern

Rows 1-6: With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows – 6 Zigzags.

Rows 7-12: With 1 strand each of B and I held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

Rows 13-15: With 1 strand of C, work in Zigzag pattern for 3 rows.

Rows 16-21: With 1 strand of F, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

Rows 22-25: With 1 strand each of A and E held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 4 rows.

Rows 26-31: With 1 strand of G, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

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Rows 32-34: With 1 strand each of H, J, and I held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 3 rows.

Rows 35-38: With 1 strand of B, work in Zigzag pattern for 4 rows.

Rows 39-44: With 1 strand of G, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

Rows 45-47: With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 3 rows.

Rows 48-53: With 1 strand of F, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

Rows 54-62: With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 9 rows.

Rows 63-109: Rep Rows 7-53.

Rows 110-115: With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, work in Zigzag pattern for 6 rows.

With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, knit 3 rows.

With 1 strand each of A and D held tog, bind off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut twenty-six 18 in. (45.5 cm) strands each of A, B, C, D, E, H, I, and J. Join 13 fringes across cast-on edge and 13 fringes across bound-off edge, attaching the fringes to each peak and valley of the Zigzags across edges as follows: Hold 1 strand of each of the 8 colors tog and fold in half. With crochet hook, draw fold through edge of Throw, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Trim fringe ends evenly.

Weave in ends.

yo = yarn over
