

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice®-BonBons Sunday Brunch Cap and Cowl Pattern Number: L32379



# SKILL LEVEL - Experienced

## SIZE

## Cap

**Finished Circumference** About 19 in. (48 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes. **Cowl** 

**Finished Circumference** About 45 in. (114.5 cm) at widest point. **Finished Length** About 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) at shortest point

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 099 Linen 2 balls (A)
  - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® BonBons (Art. #601)
  - 650 Party 1 package (B)
  - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size E-4 (3.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



Rnds 1-3 of Square = 5 in. (12.5 cm) with size J-10 (6 mm) hook and A. Rnds 1-3 of Square = 4 3/4 in. (12 cm) with size I-9 (5.5 mm) hook and A. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

## Surface Slip Stitch

- 1. Make a slip knot, but do not place it on hook.
- 2. Insert hook from RS to WS through crochet fabric.
- 3. Place the slip knot on hook and draw loop to RS (keep beg tail and working yarn on WS).
- 4. \*Insert hook from RS to WS through fabric a short distance from last insertion location, yarn over, draw loop through fabric and through loop on hook (surface sl st made); rep from \* inserting hook, as desired, to create surface pattern.
- Fasten off.

**Note:** To end a section of surface sl sts. Remove hook from loop and take hook to WS. Insert hook from WS to RS, place loop on hook, draw loop through to WS. Cut yarn. Draw tail through final loop and pull tight.

# STITCH EXPLANATION

**dc2tog (dc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

tr5 (4, 3)tog (tr 5 (4, 3) sts together) Holding back last loop of each st, work a tr in each of next 5 (4, 3) sts, then yo and through all 6 (5, 4) loops to complete.

#### French Knot

Thread needle and bring from back to front through piece. Wrap yarn around needle 6 times, insert needle back into piece close to where it emerged. Pull through and tighten knot.

## **NOTES**

- Cap and Cowl are made from individual Squares which are joined on last round. All Squares are worked the same until Rnd 3 when Squares are joined on either 1 side or 2 sides. Last Squares are joined on 3 sides to form Cowl.
- 2. Cap is made of 4 joined Squares. Stitches are picked up along one long edge to work top of Cap, and along opposite long edge to work the brim
- 3. Cowl is made of 14 Squares which are joined following a diagram. Edges are joined to make Cowl and form a triangular point on the front.
- 4. Edging is worked around finished Cap and Cowl and a French knot is embroidered in center of each Square with B.

# **CAP**

#### SQUARE 1

With size I-9 (5.5 mm) hook and A, ch 4, join with a sl st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 8 (counts as first dc, ch 5), dc in ring, \*ch 3, dc in ring, ch 5, dc in ring; rep from \* twice more, join with dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-8 (counts as last ch-3 sp) – 4 ch-5 sps and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 2:** SI st in last sp (ch-3 sp) of Rnd 1, ch 4 (counts as first tr on this row and on all following rows), 4 tr in same sp, \*ch 6, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 6, 5 tr in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* twice more, ch 6, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 6, join with sl st in top of beg ch-4-4 groups of 5 tr and 8 ch-6 sps.

Rnd 3: Ch 4, tr4tog through back loops of next 4 tr (first petal made), \*(ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr (petal made); rep from \* twice more, (ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6, join with sl st in top of first tr4tog – 4 petals and 12 ch-6 sps.

Fasten off.

#### **SQUARES 2 AND 3**

### Joined On One Side

Work Rnds 1-2 as for Square 1.

**Joining Rnd 3:** Ch 4, tr4tog through back loops of next 4 tr, (ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square) twice, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr of working Square, \*(ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6,

tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr; rep from \* once more, (ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6, join with sl st in top of first tr4tog.

#### **SQUARE 4**

# Joined On Two Opposite Sides To Form A Ring

Work Rnds 1-2 as for Square 1.

**Joining Rnd 3:** Ch 4, tr4tog through back loops of next 4 tr, ch 3, (ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square) twice, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 space of previous Square, ch 3, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr of working Square, (ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr, (ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of Square 1, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 spof working Square) twice, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of Square 1, ch 3, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr of working Square, (ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp) twice, ch 6, join with sl st in top of first tr4tog. Fasten off.

# **Shape Crown** (top of Cap)

Rnd 1: With RS facing, size I-9 (5.5 mm) hook and working along one long edge of joined Squares, join A with sI st to center ch-6 sp of one Square, sc in same sp, \*ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 2, dc in top of petal point, ch 2, tr in sc-join between Squares, ch 2, dc in top of petal point of next square, ch 2, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp; rep from \* twice more, ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 2, dc in top of petal point, ch 2, tr in sc-join between Squares, ch 2, dc in top of petal point of next square, ch 2, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 4, join with sI st to first sc.

Rnd 2: (Ch 3, sc in next ch-sp) 23 times, ch 3, join with sl st in base of beg ch-3 – 24 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 3: Ch 6 (counts as first dc, ch 3), (dc2tog over next 2 ch-3 sps, ch 3) 12 times, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 13 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 4 (counts as first sc, ch 3), (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 13 times, join with sl st to 2nd ch of beg ch-4 – 14 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 4, (tr3tog over next 3 ch-sps, ch 1, tr4tog over next 4 ch-sps) twice. Fasten off.

#### Brim

**Rnd 1:** With RS facing and working along opposite edge of Squares, rep Rnd 1 of Crown.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, work 4 sc in each ch-4 sp and 2 sc in each ch-2 sp around, join with sl st in first sc – 64 sc.

**Rnds 3-8:** Working in back loops only, sc around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off A.

**Rnd 9:** With smallest hook and color of your choice from B package, work Surface Slip Stitch around each st of last row. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

With large-eyed blunt needle and 2 strands of color of your choice from B package, work an 'X' in the center of each Square and at top of crown then embroider a French knot in center of each X.

Weave in ends

## **COWL**

## **SQUARES 1-5**

#### Joined On One Side

With size J-10 (6 mm) hook and A and following Diagram, work Squares 1-5 same as Squares 1 and 2 of Cap, joining each new Square along one side.

## **SQUARES 6, 7 AND 8**

# Joined On Two Adjacent Sides

Work Rnds 1-2 as for Square 1.

**Joining Rnd 3:** Ch 4, tr4tog through back loops of next 4 tr, \*(ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr of working Square, ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, working in corresponding petal points in corner of 3 Squares, tr3tog\*\*; rep from \* to \*\* to join second side or working Square to next Square, work rem sides as for Square 1. Fasten off.

#### **SQUARES 9-10**

Following Diagram, work as for Square 2, joining along one side edge.

#### **SQUARES 11-12**

Following Diagram, work as for Square 6, joining along two adjacent sides.

#### **SQUARE 13**

## **Joined On Two Opposite Sides**

Work Rnds 1-2 as for Square 1.

Following Diagram and lining up corner edges (marked A) of Square 13 with Square 4, work as for Square 4 of Cap, joining along two opposite side edges.

#### **SQUARE 14**

#### Joined On Three Sides

Work Rnds 1-2 as for Square 1.

**Joining Rnd 3:** Ch 4, tr4tog through back loops of next 4 tr, \*(ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square) twice, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of working Square, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, tr5tog through back loops of next 5 tr of working Square, ch 3, sc in corresponding ch-6 sp of previous Square, ch 3, working in corresponding petal points in corner of 3 Squares, tr3tog\*\*; rep from \* to \*\* twice

to join second side to next Square and third side to Square 8, lining up corners (marked B), work last side as for Square 1.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

# **Neck Edging**

Rnd 1: With RS facing, size J-10 (6 mm) hook and working along neck edge of joined Squares, join A with sl st to center ch-6 sp of one Square, sc in same sp, \*ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 2, dc in top of petal point, ch 2, tr in sc-join between Squares, ch 2, dc in top of petal point of next square, ch 2, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp; rep from \* around to first Square, ch 4, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 2, dc in top of petal point, ch 2, tr in sc-join between Squares, ch 2, dc in top of petal point of next square, ch 2, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 4, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), work 4 hdc in each ch-4 sp and 2 hdc in each ch-2 sp around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), working in back loops only, hdc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2. Fasten off A.

**Rnd 4:** With size E-4 (3.5 mm) hook and B work Surface Slip Stitch through the sts of the last rnd. Fasten off.

# **Lower Edging**

With RS facing and size E-4 (3.5 mm) hook, join color of your choice from B package with sl st in any ch-sp, \*ch 4, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* around, join with sl st in base of beg ch-4. Fasten off.

With large-eyed blunt needle and 2 strands of color of your choice from B package, work an 'X' in center of each Square, then embroider a French knot in center of each X.

Weave in ends.
