



Free Crochet Pattern
Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®
Carrington Poncho
Pattern Number: L50247



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 48 x 60 in. (122 x 152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Art. #640)
 - 143 Claret 10 balls (A)
 - 149 Charcoal 2 balls (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

8 hdc + 5 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Left and right fronts are worked separately, then joined to work the back.
2. Two yarn colors are used on every row. Use a separate ball of yarn for each section of color.
3. Before you begin the back, wind one ball of A yarn into two separate balls. You'll need these to finish the separate color sections on the back.
4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color.

PONCHO

Right Front

With A, ch 40; with B ch 10 – you will have a total of 50 ch.

Row 1 (RS): With B, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in next 7 ch; with A, hdc in each ch across – you will have 48 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn. With A, hdc in each A st across, changing to B in last st; with B, hdc in each B st across.

Rows 3-40: Continue as established, working in rows of hdc and keeping A sts in A and B sts in B.

Fasten off.

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Left Front

With B, ch 8; with A ch 42 – you will have a total of 50 ch.

Row 1 (RS): With A, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in next 39 ch; with B, hdc in last 8 ch – you will have 48 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: With B, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn. With B, hdc in each B st across, changing to A in last st; with A, hdc in each A st across.

Rows 3-40: Continue as established, working in rows of hdc and keeping A sts in A and B sts in B.

At the end of Row 40, do not fasten off.

Join for Back

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc in next 40 sts of Left Front; with B, hdc in next 8 sts of Left Front and first 8 sts of last row of Right Front; with A, hdc in last 40 sts of Right Front – you will have 96 hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-35: Continue as established, working in rows of hdc and keeping A sts in A and B sts in B.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

hdc = half double crochet

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

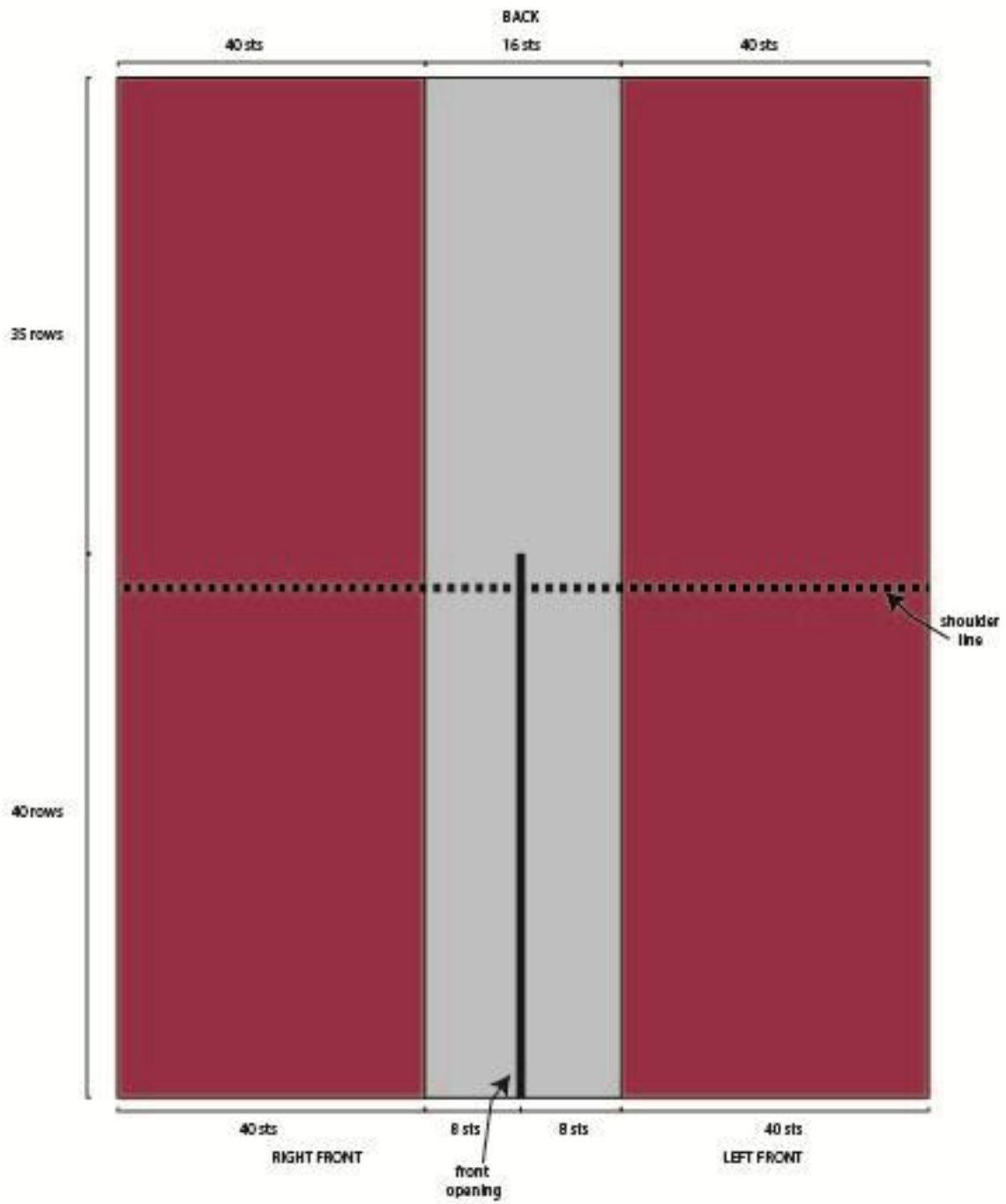
