## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 8 1/2 x 40 in. (21.5 x 101.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice (Art. #860)
  - 100 White 1 ball (A)
  - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour® (Art. #861)
  - 153 Onyx 1 ball (B)
  - 150 Platinum 1 ball (C)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

5 V-sts + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATION**

**V-st (V-stitch)** Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

### **NOTES**

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. Yarns B and C are worked with 2 strands held together. Wind B and C into 2 separate balls each before beginning.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
4. We've provided a stitch diagram to clarify the pattern.

### **SCARF**

With 1 strand of A, ch 34.

**Row 1 (RS):** V-st in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), \*sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 10 V-sts, 1 dc at beg of row, and 1 dc at end of row.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch.

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Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 28 in. (71 cm) from beg and change to 2 strands of B held tog at the end of the last row.

**Next 7 Rows:** With 2 strands of B held tog, rep Row 2 for 7 rows and change to 1 strand each of B and C held tog at the end of the last row.

**Next 7 Rows:** With 1 strand each of B and C held tog, rep Row 2 for 7 rows and change to 2 strands of C held tog at the end of the last row.

**Next 7 Rows:** With 2 strands of C held tog, rep Row 2 for 7 rows.  
Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## **Fringe**

Cut strands of yarns as desired, each strand about 16 in. (40.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 4-6 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make fringes along each end of Scarf.

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together
