



Free Crochet Pattern
Lion Brand® Heartland®
Hayward Shrug
Pattern Number: L40732



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

S-L (1X-3X)

Finished Bust About 52 (60) in. (132 (152.5) cm)

Finished Back Width About 27 (32) in. (68.5 (81.5) cm)

Finished Length About 25 (28) in. (63.5 (71) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 353 Black Canyon Tweed 3 (4) balls (A)
 - 135 Yosemite 1 (2) ball(s) (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

13 hdc + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shrug is made in one piece, then assembled following a diagram.
2. Border is worked in a contrast color. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Do not carry color not in use across WS of piece. Instead, leave color not in use on WS of piece until next needed. If you are making the smallest size, wind B into 2 separate balls before beginning.

SHRUG

Lower Border for First Front

With B, ch 12.

Row 1 (RS): Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 11 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across to last st; working in both loops, hdc in last st.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across to last st; working in both loops, sc in last st.

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Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 12 1/2 (14) in. (32 (35.5) cm) from beg, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work.
Do not fasten off.

First Front

Row 1 (RS): Working across long edge of lower border, work 40 (46) sc as evenly spaced as possible as follows: work the first 11 sc with B, then change to A and work the rem 29 (35) sc with A – 40 (46) sc.

Row 2: With A, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 11 sts; change to B, working in back loops only, hdc in next 10 sts; working in both loops, hdc in last st.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first 11 sts; change to A, working in both loops, hdc in each st across.

Rows 4-23 (27): Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 10 (12) more times.

Increase for Back

Row 1 (Increase Row - WS): With A, ch 29 (35); with a second ball of B, ch 12, turn, with B, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (skipped 2 ch count as first hdc), hdc in next 9 ch; change to A, hdc each ch and st across to last 11 sts; change to B, working in back loops only, hdc in next 10 sts; working in both loops, hdc in last st – 80 (92) hdc.

Row 2: With B, ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first 11 sts; change to A, working in both loops, hdc in each st to last 11 sts; change to B, working in back loops only, sc in next 10 sts; working in both loops, sc in last st.

Row 3: With B, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, working in back loops only, hdc in next 10 sts; change to A, working in both loops, hdc in each st to last 11 sts; change to B, working in back loops only, hdc in next 10 sts; working in both loops, hdc in last st.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 27 (32) in. (68.5 (81.5) cm) from Row 1 (Increase Row), end with a Row 3 as the last row you work.

Decrease for Second Front

Row 1 (RS): With B, ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first 11 sts; change to A, working in both loops, hdc in next 29 (35) sts; leave rem sts unworked – 40 (46) sts.

Row 2: With A, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 11 sts; change to B, working in back loops only, hdc in next 10 sts; working in both loops, hdc in last st.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first 11 sts; change to A, working in both loops, hdc in each st across.

Rows 4-23 (27): Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 10 (12) more times.

Fasten off.

Lower Border for Second Front

Work same as Lower Border for First Front.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew one long edge of border to last row of Second Front.

FINISHING

Assembly

Step 1: Following diagram, fold fronts over back.

Step 2: Sew side seams for about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm) beg at lower edge, leaving about 8 (9 1/2) in. (20.5 (24) cm) open for armholes.

Armhole Edging

From RS, join B with a sl st in armhole edge at seam.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 48 (58) sc as evenly spaced as possible around armhole; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 2 and 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 4: Turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each st around; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

hdc = half double crochet

rem = remain(ing)(s)

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip st

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

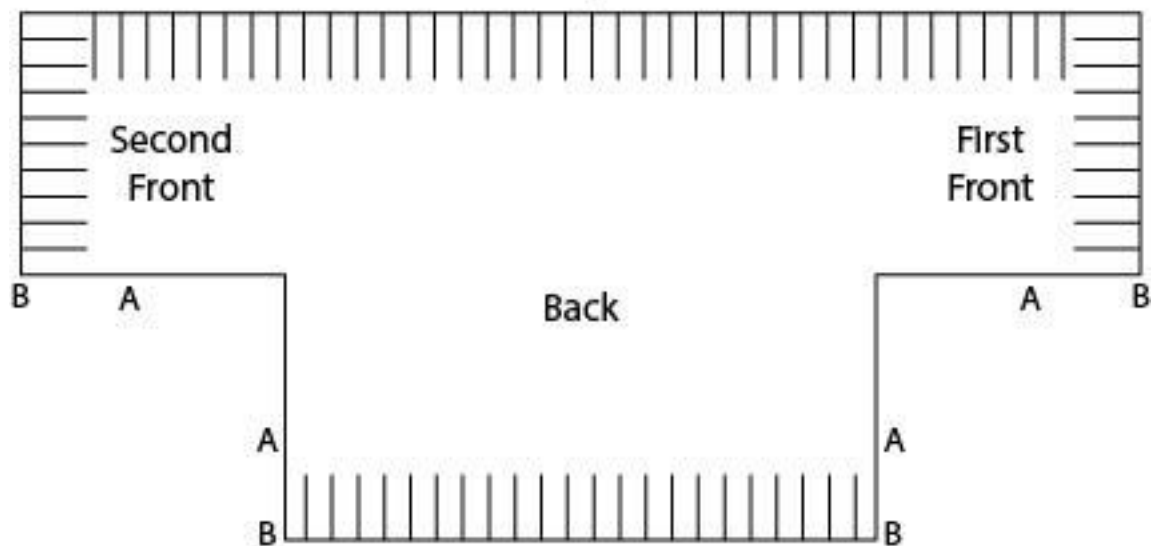
