

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Shawl In A Ball 5 Ball Ripple Afghan Pattern Number: L60097



# SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 44 x 60 in. (112 x 152.5 cm)

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball (Art. #828)
  - 207 Feng Shui Grey 2 balls (A)
  - 203 Mindful Mauve 3 balls (B)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **GAUGE**

1 ripple + 7 1/2 rows = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 2. The ripple in this design is created by skipping 2 sts to form 'valleys' and working 3 dc to form 'peaks'. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each valley and work 3 dc in the center dc of each 3-dc peak of the previous row.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

# <u>AFGHAN</u>

With A, ch 174.

**Row 1:** With A, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), \*dc in next 7 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, 3 dc in next ch; rep from \* to last 17 ch, dc in next 7 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, 2 dc in last ch – you will have 10 ripples in this and all following rows.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, \*dc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 3 dc in next st; rep from \* to last 17 sts, dc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in top of beginning ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beginning, change to B in last st of last row.

With B, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 48 in. (122 cm) from beginning, change to A in last st of last row. With A, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 60 in. (152.5 cm) from beginning. Do NOT fasten off.

#### **First Edging**

With A, ch 1, turn, slip st in each st across. Fasten off.

#### Second Edging

From right side, working across opposite side of foundation ch, join A with a slip st to first ch. Ch 1, slip st in each ch across. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
