## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy+**

### **SIZES**

S/M (L-2X)

**Finished Bust** About 45 (53) in. (114.5 (134.5) cm), closed

**Finished Length** About 28 1/2 (29 1/2) in. (72.5 (75) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Style (Art. #867)
  - 147 Purple 1 (2) ball(s) (A)
  - 124 Camel 1 (2) ball(s) (B)
  - 114 Denim 1 (2) ball(s) (C)
  - 174 Olive 1 (2) ball(s) (D)
  - 146 Fuchsia 1 (2) ball(s) (E)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Color Waves (Art. #595)
  - 203 Deep Blue Sea 1 (2) ball(s) (F)
  - 207 Prairie Sunset 1 (2) ball(s) (G)
  - 205 Green Apple 1 (2) ball(s) (H)
  - 216 Rainbow 1 (2) ball(s) (I)
  - 204 Cactus Flower 1 (2) ball(s) (J)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 10 (6 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

4 buttons, about 1 1/2 in. (38 mm) diameter

Sewing needle and thread

### **GAUGE**

12 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Seed st with 1 strand each of E and J held together.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

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## **STITCH EXPLANATION**

**kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

## **PATTERN STITCH**

**Seed St (worked over an even number of sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** P the knit sts, and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

## **NOTES**

1. Cardigan is worked in 7 pieces: Back, 2 Fronts, 2 Sleeves, and 2 Pocket Linings.
2. Each piece is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog. Yarn colors are changed to make stripes.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
4. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.

## **BACK**

With 1 strand each of E and J held tog, cast on 68 (80) sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st changing yarn colors as follows: Work 8 rows with E and J held tog, 4 rows with J and D held tog, 6 rows with D and H held tog, 4 rows with C and H held tog, 2 rows with C and I held tog, 10 rows with A and I held tog, 6 rows with A and F held tog, 4 rows with C and F held tog, 10 rows with C and G held tog, 6 rows with E and G held tog, 8 rows with E and I held tog, 8 rows with D and I held tog, 6 rows with J and D held tog, 8 rows with B and J held tog, and 6 rows with B and G held tog.

## **Shape Armholes**

Change to 1 strand each of E and G held tog.

**Rows 1 and 2:** Bind off 4 (5) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – you will have 60 (70) sts at the end of Row 2.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Bind off 3 (4) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 54 (62) sts at the end of Row 4.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Bind off 2 (3) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 50 (56) sts at the end of Row 6.

**Rows 7 and 8:** Bind off 1 (2) st(s), work in Seed st to end of row – 48 (52) sts at the end of Row 8.

Work even in Seed st changing yarn colors as follows: Work 4 (6) rows with E and F held tog, 8 rows with A and F held tog, 6 rows with A and H held tog, 2 (4) rows with D and H held tog, 10 rows with D and J held tog, and 4 (6) rows with B and J held tog.

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### Shape Shoulders

Continue working with 1 strand each of B and J held tog.

**Rows 1-4:** Bind off 7 sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 20 (24) sts rem.  
Bind off.

### LEFT POCKET LINING

With 1 strand each of C and H held tog, cast on 16 sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st changing yarn color as in following stripe sequence: Work 12 rows with C and H held tog, 12 rows with B and H held tog, and 8 rows with B and I held tog.

Place sts on a stitch holder and cut yarn.

### LEFT FRONT

**Note:** To make a neat front edge, always slip the first st of every WS row until you reach the section of the Left Front marked 'Shape Neck'. You can slip the first st as if to knit or as if to purl – whichever looks neatest with your style of knitting.

With 1 strand each of E and F held tog, cast on 38 (44) sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st changing yarn color as follows: Work 6 rows with E and F held tog, 8 rows with A and F held tog, 14 rows with A and I held tog, 6 rows with B and I held tog, and 8 rows with B and H held tog.

### Join Pocket Lining

Change to 1 strand each of D and H held tog.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work in Seed st over first 11 (14) sts, bind off next 16 sts, work in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 2:** Work in Seed st over first 11 (14) sts, continue in Seed st over 16 Pocket Lining sts on holder, work in Seed st to end of row.

Work even in Seed st changing yarn colors as follows: Work 4 more rows with D and H held tog, 6 rows with D and J held tog, 8 rows with C and J held tog, 8 rows with C and G held tog, 8 rows with E and G held tog, 6 rows with E and F held tog, 8 rows with A and F held tog, and 4 rows with A and H held tog.

### Shape Armhole

Continue with 1 strand each of A and H held tog.

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 4 (5) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 34 (39) sts.

**Rows 2 and 4:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 3:** Bind off 3 (4) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 31 (35) sts.

Change to 1 strand each of D and H held tog.

**Row 5:** Bind off 2 (3) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 29 (32) sts.

**Row 6:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 7:** Bind off 1 (2) st(s), work in Seed st to end of row – 28 (30) sts.

Work even in Seed st working 3 (5) more rows with D and H held tog, 10 (12) rows with D and J held tog, and 7 (9) rows with B and J held tog.

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### Shape Neck

Continue with 1 strand each of B and J held tog.

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 14 (16) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 14 sts.

Change to 1 strand each of B and I held tog.

Work even in Seed st for 14 rows.

### Shape Shoulder

Continue with 1 strand each of B and I held tog.

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 7 sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 7 sts.

**Row 2:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

Bind off rem 7 sts.

### RIGHT POCKET LINING

With 1 strand each of C and H held tog, cast on 16 sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st changing yarn colors as follows: Work 12 rows with B and H held tog, 12 rows with C and H held tog, and 8 rows with C and F held tog.

Place sts on a stitch holder and cut yarn.

### RIGHT FRONT

**Note:** To make a neat front edge, always slip the first st of every RS row until you reach the section of the Right Front marked 'Shape Neck'. You can slip the first st as if to knit or as if to purl – whichever looks neatest with your style of knitting.

With 1 strand each of D and I held tog, cast on 38 (44) sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st changing yarn colors as follows: Work 10 rows with D and I held tog, 8 rows with C and I held tog, 6 rows with C and J held tog, 6 rows with B and J held tog, and 8 rows with B and F held tog.

### First Buttonhole

Change to 1 strand each of A and F held tog.

**Buttonhole Row 1 (RS):** Work in Seed st over first 4 sts, bind off 2 sts for buttonhole, work in Seed st to end of row.

**Buttonhole Row 2:** Work in Seed st across to bound off sts, casting on 2 sts over bound-off sts of previous row.

Work even in Seed st for 2 rows.

### Join Pocket Lining

Continue with 1 strand each of A and F held tog.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work in Seed st over first 11 (14) sts, bind off next 16 sts, work in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 2:** Work in Seed st over first 11 (14) sts, continue in Seed st over 16 Pocket Lining sts on holder, work in Seed st to end of row.

Work even in Seed st working 2 more rows with A and F held tog, then 8 rows with A and G held tog.

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### Second Buttonhole

Change to 1 strand each of E and G held tog.

Rep Buttonhole Rows 1 and 2.

Work even in Seed st working 6 more rows with E and G held tog, then 8 rows with E and I held tog.

### Third Buttonhole

Change to 1 strand each of B and I held tog.

Rep Buttonhole Rows 1 and 2.

Work even in Seed st working 2 more rows with B and I held tog, 6 rows with B and J held tog, and 6 rows with D and J held tog.

### Fourth Buttonhole

Change to 1 strand each of D and H held tog.

Rep Buttonhole Rows 1 and 2.

Work even in Seed st working 8 more rows with D and H held tog, then 1 row with C and H held tog.

### Shape Armhole

Continue with 1 strand each of C and H held tog.

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 4 (5) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 34 (39) sts.

**Rows 2 and 4:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 3:** Bind off 3 (4) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 31 (35) sts.

**Row 5:** Bind off 2 (3) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 29 (32) sts.

Change to 1 strand each of C and F held tog.

**Row 6:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 7:** Bind off 1 (2) st(s), work in Seed st to end of row – 28 (30) sts.

Work even in Seed st working 8 (10) more rows with C and F held tog, 6 (8) rows with A and F held tog, and 6 (8) rows with A and G held tog.

### Shape Neck

Continue with 1 strand each of A and G held tog.

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 14 (16) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 14 sts.

Change to 1 strand each of B and I held tog.

Work even in Seed st working 1 more row with A and G held tog, 8 rows with E and G held tog, and 5 rows with E and J held tog.

### Shape Shoulder

Continue with 1 strand each of E and J held tog.

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 7 sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 7 sts.

**Row 2:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

Bind off rem 7 sts.



## LEFT SLEEVE

With 1 strand each of B and H held tog, cast on 32 (34) sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st for 8 (6) rows.

Change to 1 strand each of B and J held tog.

**Increase Row (RS):** K1, kfb, work in Seed st to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 34 (36) sts.

Work even in Seed st for 3 (2) rows, working the increased sts into Seed st.

Change to 1 strand each of C and J held tog.

Work even in Seed st for 4 (3) rows.

Rep last 8 (6) rows 8 (12) more times changing yarn colors as follows: Work 6 rows with C and F held tog, 6 rows with A and F held tog, 4 (6) rows with A and G held tog, 6 (8) rows with E and G held tog, 6 rows with E and I held tog, 12 rows with B and I held tog, 8 rows with B and H held tog, 4 (6) rows with D and H held tog, 8 rows with D and F held tog, and 4 (6) rows with C and F held tog – 50 (60) sts.

Continue with 1 strand each of C and F held tog.

Work even in Seed st for 4 rows.

## Shape Cap (top of Sleeve)

Change to 1 strand each of C and G held tog.

**Rows 1 and 2:** Bind off 4 (5) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – you will have 42 (50) sts at the end of Row 2.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Bind off 3 (4) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 36 (42) sts at the end of Row 4.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Bind off 2 (3) sts, work in Seed st to end of row – 32 (36) sts at the end of Row 6.

**Rows 7-12:** Bind off 1 st, work in Seed st to end of row – 26 (30) sts at the end of Row 12.

Change to 1 strand each of A and G held tog and rep Row 7 for 12 (16) more times – 14 sts rem.

Bind off.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

With 1 strand each of C and G held tog, cast on 32 (34) sts.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st for 8 (6) rows.

Change to 1 strand each of C and F held tog.

**Increase Row (RS):** K1, kfb, work in Seed st to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 34 (36) sts.

Work even in Seed st for 7 (5) rows, working the increased sts into Seed st pattern.

Rep last 8 (6) rows 8 (12) more times changing yarn colors as follows: Work 4 rows with A and F held tog, 4 rows with A and H held tog, 8 (10) rows with B and H held tog, 10 (12) rows with B and I held tog, 12 rows with A and I held tog, 6 rows with A and F held tog, 6 rows with D and F held tog, 10 (12) rows with D and J held tog, and 4 (6) rows with E and J held tog – 50 (60) sts.

Continue with 1 strand each of E and J held tog.

Work even in Seed st for 4 rows.

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### **Shape Cap (top of Sleeve)**

Change to 1 strand each of E and G held tog and rep Rows 1-12 of Left Sleeve Cap.

Change to 1 strand each of B and G held tog and rep Row 7 of Left Sleeve Cap for 12 (16) more times – 14 sts rem.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams.

### **Collar**

From RS with 1 strand each of A and F held tog, beg at right front neck edge (not including bound-off sts), pick up and k15 sts evenly spaced along right neck edge to shoulder seam, 20 (24) sts evenly spaced along back neck edge, and 15 sts along left neck edge – 50 (54) sts.

**Row 1:** Work even in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 2 (Increase Row):** K1, kfb, work in Seed st to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 52 (56) sts.

Rep Row 2 for 11 more times changing yarn colors as follows: Work 3 more rows with A and F held tog, 4 rows with D and F held tog, and 4 rows with D and G held tog – 74 (78) sts when all increases have been completed.

Work even in Seed st working 4 rows with E and G held tog, then 4 rows with E and J held tog.

Bind off.

Sew side edges of first 14 rows of collar to bound-off edges of each front neck. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Sew edges of Pocket Linings to WS of Fronts. With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
