Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball
Catherine Wheel Shawl
Pattern Number: L60033



SKILL LEVEL - Intermediate

SIZE

About 18 x 70 in. (45.5 x 178 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball (Art. #828)
 - 200 Community Coral 1 ball (A)
 - 203 Mindful Mauve 1 ball (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 pattern reps = about 5 in. (12.5 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep consists of 10 sts: One 7-dc Shell and the following 3 sc in odd-numbered rows, or 1 dc7tog and the following ch-3, 3 sc, and ch-3 in even-numbered rows.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Beg Half-Shell Work 3 dc in indicated st.

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

dc4tog (dc 4 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 4 times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

dc7tog (dc 7 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 7 times, yarn over and draw through all 8 loops on hook.

Half-Shell Work 4 dc in indicated st.

Shell Work 7 dc in indicated st.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece.
2. The yarn color is changed on every other row.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Do not fasten off old color until instructed. Carry old color not in use up side edge of piece until next needed.

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4. The Catherine Wheel pattern stitch is easy to do! For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a diagram.

SHAWL

With A, ch 74.

Row 1: Beg Half-Shell in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch and Beg Half-Shell count as first full Half-Shell), sk next 3 ch, sc in next 3 ch, *sk next 3 ch, Shell in next ch, sk next 3 ch, sc in next 3 ch; rep from * to last 4 ch, sk next 3 ch, Half-Shell in last ch and change to B in last st – you will have 6 Shells and 1 Half-Shell at beg and end of this row.

Row 2: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, ch 3, dc7tog, *ch 3, sc in next 3 sts, ch 3, dc7tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 3, sc in next st, sc in top of beg ch – 7 dc7tog.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, sk next ch-3 sp, Shell in next st, *sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 sts, sk next ch-3 sp, Shell in next st; rep from * to last ch-3 sp, sk last ch-3 sp, sc in last 2 sts and change to A in last st – 7 Shells.

Row 4: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc3tog, ch 3, sc in next 3 sts, *ch 3, dc7tog, ch 3, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 4 sts, ch 3, dc4tog – 6 dc7tog.

Row 5: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), Beg Half-Shell in first st (beg ch-3 and Beg Half-Shell count as first full Half-Shell), sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 sts, *sk next ch-3 sp, Shell in next st, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to last ch-3 sp, Half-Shell in last st and change to B in last st.

Rep Rows 2-5 until almost all yarn is used, working a Row 3 as the last row you work.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep(s) = repeat(s)

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)
