

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® SCARFIE

CHELSEA CABLE SCARF

Pattern Number: L60036



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 8 x 64 in. (20.5 x 162.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Scarfie (Art. #826)
 214 Cream/Mustard 2 balls
 or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® cable needle
- Lion Brand[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 40 in. (101.5 cm) long



GAUGE

33 sts + 20 rows = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm) over Rows 1-8 of cable. 16 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over K1, p1 Rib, slightly stretched. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH PATTERN

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): Slip 1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: Slip 1, knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts across to end of row.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

NOTES

- 1. A long cable strip is worked first, then sts are picked up across one long side to work the rib portion of the Scarf.
- 2. Both the cable and the rib are reversible, so both sides of the Scarf will look great!
- 3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 4. The first stitch of every row is slipped. You can choose to slip as if to knit or slip as if to purl whichever looks best with your style of knitting.

Note:

The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied August 06th, 2021)

Cable Row 1 (RS): Work in rib as established over 3 sts, slip next 6 sts to a cable needle (cn) and hold in front of work, (p1, k1) 3 times, then (p1, k1) 3 times from cn, work in rib as established to end of row. Rows 2-4: Work in rib as established.

Row 5: Work in rib as established over 18 sts, slip next 6 sts to cn and hold in back of work, (k1, p1) 3 times, then (k1, p1) 3 times from cn, work in rib as established to end of row.

SCARF

Cable Strip

Cast on 33 sts.

Beg with Row 1, work in K1, p1 Rib for 2 rows.

Cable

Row 1 (RS): Work in rib as established over 3 sts, slip next 6 sts to a cable needle (cn) and hold in front of work, (p1, k1) 3 times, then (p1, k1) 3 times from cn, work in rib as established to end of row.

Rows 2-4: Work in rib as established.

Row 5: Work in rib as established over 18 sts, slip next 6 sts to cn and hold in back of work, (k1, p1) 3 times, then (k1, p1) 3 times from cn, work in rib as established to end of row.

Rows 6-8: Work in rib as established.

Rep Rows 1-8 until piece measures about 63 in. (160 cm) from beg, end with a

Row 8 as the last row you work.

Work in rib as established for one row.

Bind off in rib.

Ribbed Section of Scarf

From RS, pick up and k267 sts evenly spaced across one long edge of Cable strip.

Beg with Row 1, work in K1, p1 Rib for about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

Bind off in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(s)(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 together

p = purl

rem = remain(s)(ing)

rep = repeat(s)(ing)

RS = right side

St st = Stockinette stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
