

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Scarfie Concord Hat and Wrist Warmers

Pattern Number: L60009



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

HAT

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes **Finished Height** About 9 1/2 in. (24 cm)

MITTS

Finished Circumference About 8 in. (20.5 cm) Finished Height About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Scarfie (Art. #826)
 - 211 Black/Purple 1 ball
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

12 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc-blo (half double crochet in back loop only) Yarn over, insert hook in back loop only of indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES

- Hat and Wrist Warmers are worked back and forth in rows. Increases are worked on one edge and decreases on the other edge to create a diagonal pattern.
- 2. Sides of Hat are seamed, then a crochet tie is woven through the top of Hat to gather it.
- 3. Wrist Warmers are seamed, leaving an opening for thumb.

HAT

Ch 36.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 35 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc-blo in next st, dc in top of beg ch - 35 sts.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc-blo in first st (increase made), hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then sew short edges of piece together to make Hat.

Tie

Make a chain about 25 in. (63.5 cm) long.

Fasten off.

Weave tie in and out through spaces between sts, about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top of Hat. Pull ends of tie to gather and knot. Tie ends of tie into a bow. Weave in ends.

LEFT WRIST WARMER

Ch 31.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 30 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc-blo in next st, dc in top of beg ch – 30 sts.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc-blo in first st (increase made), hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

RIGHT WRIST WARMER

Ch 31.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 30 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc-blo in first st (increase made), hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch – 30 sts.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc-blo in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc-blo in next st. dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and sew last row to first row, leaving an opening for thumb.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

beg = begin(ning)
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
rep = repeat
sk = skip
