

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Scarfie Jewel Ripple Afghan Pattern Number: L60031



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<u>SKILL LEVEL –</u> Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 44 x 62 in. (112 x 157.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Scarfie (Art. #826)
 - 204 Denim/Navy 1 ball (A)
 - 210 Black/Royal 1 ball (B)
 - 209 Charcoal/Aqua 1 ball (C)
 - 211 Black/Purple 1 ball (D)
 - 213 Black/Hot Pink 1 ball (E)
 - 212 Charcoal/Magenta 1 ball (F)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

1 ripple + 7 1/2 rows = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 2. The ripple in this design is created by skipping 2 sts to form 'valleys' and working 3 dc to form 'peaks'. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each valley and work 3 dc in the center dc of each 3-dc peak of the previous row.
- 3. Yarn color is changed to create stripes.
- 4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

<u>AFGHAN</u>

With A, ch 140.

Row 1: With A, Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), *dc in next 7 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, 3 dc in next ch; rep from * to last 17 ch, dc in next 7 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, 2 dc in last ch – you will have 8 ripples in this and all following rows.

Row 2: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, *dc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 3 dc in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, dc in next 7



sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in top of beginning ch and change to B in last st.

Rows 3-84: Rep Row 2, changing color as follows: Work 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 10 rows with A, 6 rows with F, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with D, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with B, and 2 rows with A. At the end of Row 84, do not cut A. **Row 85:** With A, ch 1, turn, slip st in each st across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
