SIZE

Finished Size

About 10 x 20 in. (25.5 x 51 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 100 White 1 ball (A)
 - 110 Navy 1 ball (B)
 - 301 Rose Mist 1 ball (C)
 - 139 Rose Shocking 1 ball (D)
 - 109 Colonial Blue 1 ball (E)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Baby Soft® (Art. #920)
 - 100 White 1 ball (F)
 - 101 Pastel Pink 1 ball (G)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Tonal (Art. #635)
 - 113 Vermillion 1 ball (H)
 - or color of your choice
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver™ Starter Kit
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver Extender™ Kit



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

12 in. (30.5 cm) length of wooden dowel, about 1/2 in. (1.25 cm) in diameter

NOTES

1. Wall Hanging is meant to inspire your creativity! Follow the row by row instructions to make the Hanging, though you needn't follow the pattern exactly.
2. To change yarn color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail. Begin weaving with the new color leaving a long yarn tail. These tails will be woven in later.

Loom Set-Up

Following DIY Weaver Extender™ kit manual instructions, connect loom base from starter kit to loom base from extender kit.

Insert standards pegs along bottom and top rows of loom bases – 56 pegs placed for warp.

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WALL HANGING

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping set up the warp across 56 pegs with F.

Weft

Following the weaver manual instructions for Basic Weaving, weave the weft changing color as follows:

With A, weave 3 in. (7.5 cm)

Next Row: Following video instructions for Rya Weaving, work one row of Rya knots across your warp with F.

With B, following video instructions for Satin Weaving, work 5 rows.

With H, following manual instruction for Basic Weaving, work 4 rows.

With one strand of F and one strand of G, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 30 rows.

With H, following manual instruction for Basic Weaving, work 4 rows.

With B, following video instructions for Satin Weaving, work 5 rows.

With A, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 30 rows.

Next Row: Following video instructions for Rya Weaving, work one row of Rya knots across your warp with G.

With C, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 12 rows.

With A, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 2 rows.

With D, following video instructions for Satin Weaving, work 30 rows.

With E, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 4 rows.

With A, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work 30 rows.

Next Row: Following video instructions for Rya Weaving, work one row of Rya knots across your warp with D.

With A, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, weave the remainder of the warp.

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FINISHING

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

Attach Dowel

Thread the tapestry needle with yarn in color as desired. Knot end of yarn to top right corner of Hanging. Wrap yarn over dowel, then draw through top edge of Hanging. Working from right to left, continue to wrap yarn over dowel, then draw through top edge of Hanging, until Hanging is completely attached to dowel. Knot yarn, trim ends.

Hanger

Cut a 30 in. (76 cm) length of G. Tie ends of strand to ends of dowel.

Weave in yarn ends.
