The Magic Mitters Throw
Pattern Number: MagicMittersThrow

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Width About 52 inches (132 cm)

Finished Length About 52 inches (132 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion's Pride® Woolspun® (Art. #671)
 - A: 671-150, Oxford Grey, 5 skeins
 - B: 671-140, Violet, 4 skeins
 - C: 671-098, Fisherman, 4 skeins
 - D: 671-142, Orchid, 4 skeins
- Lion Brand® Crochet Hook Size K-10.5 6.5 mm
- Lion Brand® Large-eyed blunt needle
- Lion Brand® Split Ring Stitch Markers



GAUGE

12 stitches and 14 rows in single crochet/4 inches (10.2 cm), blocked

For gauge swatch, ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until swatch measures at least 4.5 inches (11.4 cm). Each row will have 20 sts. Fasten off. Lightly steam block on WS.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, use a smaller size hook; if more stitches and rows, use a larger size hook.

NOTES

To change colors or start a new skein, work last st of current skein to last yarn over. Yarn over with new skein and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new skein. Cut old skein, leaving approximately a 4-inch (10.5 cm) tail.

Each row is worked with a sc in each st including the one before the middle, 3 sc in the middle sc, then 1 sc in each remaining st. This increases each row by 2 sc.

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THE MAGIC MITERS THROW **SQUARE 1**

With A (Oxford Grey), ch 2.

Row 1 (RS): Work 3 sc into second ch from hook. Insert a stitch marker to mark as right side.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in first sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in last sc. Total 5 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each of first 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of remaining 2 sc. Total 7 sc.

Rows 4-8: Continue in pattern, changing to B (Violet) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 8.

Rows 9-10: Continue in pattern, changing to C (Fisherman) when 2 sts remain on hook at end of Row 10.

Rows 11-26: Continue in pattern, changing to B (Violet) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 26.

Rows 27-28: Continue in pattern, changing to D (Orchid) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 28.

Rows 29-44: Continue in pattern, changing to B (Violet) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 44.

Rows 45-46: Continue in pattern, changing to A (Oxford Grey) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 46.

Rows 47-62: Continue in pattern, changing to B (Violet) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 54.

Rows 63-64: Continue in pattern, changing to C (Fisherman) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 64.

Rows 65-72: Continue in pattern, changing to B (Violet) when 2 lps remain on hook at end of Row 72.

Rows 73-74. Continue in pattern. Fasten off.

Summary of Square 1:

8 rows A, 2 rows B

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16 rows C, 2 rows B
16 rows D, 2 rows B
16 Rows A, 2 rows B
8 rows C, 2 rows B

SQUARE 2

Work as Square 1 with the following color sequence:

8 Rows D, 2 rows B
16 rows C, 2 rows B
16 rows A, 2 rows B
16 rows D, 2 rows B
8 rows C, 2 rows B

SQUARE 3

Work as Square 1 with the following color sequence:

8 rows C, 2 rows B
16 rows A, 2 rows B
16 rows D, 2 rows B
16 rows C, 2 rows B
8 rows A, 2 rows B

SQUARE 4

Work as Square 1 with the following color sequence:

8 rows A, 2 rows B
16 rows D, 2 rows B
16 rows C, 2 rows B
16 rows A, 2 rows B
8 rows D, 2 rows B

FINISHING THE SQUARES AND SEAMING TOGETHER

With tapestry needle, weave in ends. Lightly steam block each square on WS.

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Arrangement of squares before seaming (WS up, smallest box in bottom left corner of each square):

2	4
1	3

Using tapestry needle and B, seam the squares together, picking up the back loop of each set of corresponding stitches. To ensure smooth seams, start at the middle and work outward one direction, then go back to the middle and work outward in the opposite direction.

EDGING

Arrangement of squares before edging (RS up, smallest box in top left corner of each square):

1	3
2	4

NOTE: Edging is only needed along the top and the left side; the bottom and the right side already have a border of B.

Row 1: With RS facing, join B in top right corner. Ch 1, sc in each row end

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across, work 3 sc in corner, sc in each row end down left side.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc up side, work 3 sc in corner, sc in each sc across top. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With tapestry needle, weave in remaining ends. Lightly steam block on WS if desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s) = chain(s)

lp(s) = loop(s)

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
