Lion Brand® Heartland®
Chevron Lace Shawl
Pattern Number: L40468



SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

SIZE

About 18 x 58 in. (45.5 x 147.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland (Art. #136)
 - 147 Hot Springs 3 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 ripples = about 6 in. (15 cm) measured from peak to peak.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

sc3tog (sc 3 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple in this design is created by working dc3tog or sc3tog to form 'valleys' and (dc, ch 3, dc) or (sc, ch 1, sc) to form 'peaks'. In each row, take care to work dc3tog or sc3tog over the 3 sts in each 'valley' and (dc, ch 3, dc) or (sc, ch 1, sc) in the center sp of each 'peak.'

SHAWL

Ch 89.

Row 1: Dc in 5th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc, ch-1), (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, *ch 1, sk next ch, dc3tog over next 3 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, ch 1, sk next ch, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice; rep from * to last 10 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, dc3tog over next 3 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, ch 1, sk next ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch – 6 ripples.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, sc3tog over next (ch-1 sp, dc3tog, ch-1 sp), *(ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, sc3tog over next (ch-1 sp, dc3tog, ch-1 sp); rep from * to last 3 ch-1 sps, (ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

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Row 3: Ch 4 (beg ch counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first sc, (ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, *ch 1, dc3tog over next (ch-1 sp, sc3tog, ch-1 sp), (ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice; rep from * to last 4 ch-1 sps, ch 1, dc3tog over next (ch-1 sp, sc3tog, ch-1 sp), (ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last st.
Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 58 in. (147.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sp(s) = space(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)
