SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

SIZE

Finished Width About 70 in. (178 cm), across top edge

Finished Length About 35 in. (89 cm), not including edging

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 300 Denim Mist 6 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

11 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece with increases worked at one edge only for shaping. The increase edge becomes the top edge of the Shawl.
2. An edging is worked around the outside edge of the Shawl.

SHAWL

Ch 2.

Row 1 (RS): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook – 2 sc.

Row 2: Ch 4 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in last st – you will have 3 dc at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to turning ch-sp, 2 sc in turning ch-sp – 5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 4 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in each st across – 6 dc.

Row 5: Rep Row 3 – 8 sc.

Row 6 (Mesh Row): Ch 6 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st; rep from * across – 3 dc, 2 ch-2 sps and 1 turning ch-sp.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch to turning ch-sp, sc in first 2 ch of turning ch, 2 sc in turning ch-sp – 11 sc.

Row 8: Rep Row 4 – 12 dc.

Rows 9 and 10: Rep Rows 3 and 4 – 15 dc.

Row 11: Rep Row 3 – 17 sc.

Rows 12-89: Rep Rows 6-11 thirteen more times – you will have 134 sts at the end of Row 89.

Do not fasten off.

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Top Edging

Row 1 (RS): Rotate piece to work in ends of rows across long side edge (top edge of Shawl), ch 2 (does not count as a st), work 1 hdc in end of each sc row, 3 hdc in end of each dc row, 4 hdc in end of each mesh row, and 1 hdc in edge of foundation row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st.
DO NOT fasten off.

Bottom Edging

Row 1 (RS): Rotate piece to work in ends of rows across next side edge, ch 1, sc in end of each of the 3 top edging rows; working in ends of rows across Shawl edge, work 1 sc in foundation ch at base of first sc, work 1 sc in end of each sc row, 2 sc in end of each dc row, and 2 sc in end of each mesh row to corner (for a total of 134 sc worked evenly across Shawl edge plus 3 sc worked in ends of top edging rows), 3 sc in corner (lower point); working in sts of next edge, sc in each st across to top edging row, work sc in end of each of the 3 top edging rows – 277 sc (137 sts on each side of 3-sc corner).

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to center sc of 3-sc corner, 3 sc in center st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st – 281 sc (139 sts on each side of 3-sc corner).

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, *sc in next st, ch 3, sk next 3 sts; rep from * to center sc of 3-sc corner, (sc, ch 3, sc) in center st, **ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st; rep from ** to end of row – 72 sc and 71 ch-3 sps (35 ch-3 sps on each side of corner ch-3 sp).

Row 4: Turn, sl st in first st, (sl st, ch 1, 3 sc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, *3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from * to corner ch-3 sp, 5 sc in corner ch-3 sp, **ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from ** to end of row – 215 sc (Thirty-five 3-sc groups on each side of corner 5-sc group) and 70 ch-1 sps.

Row 5: Turn, sl st in first st, ch 1, sc in next st (center st of first 3-sc group), *ch 2, (2 dc, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch 1, 2 dc) in center st of next 3-sc group, ch 2, sc in next center st of next 3-sc group; rep from * to corner 5-sc group, (3 dc, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch 1, 3 dc) in center st of 5-sc corner, ch 2, sc in center st of next 3-sc group, **ch 2, (2 dc, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch 1, 2 dc) in center st of next 3-sc group, ch 2, sc in center st of next 3-sc group; rep from ** to end of row, sl st in last st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

sp(s) = space(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)
