SKILL LEVEL – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 20 x 62 in. (51 x 157.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun ®
 - (Art. #790)
 - 418 Ambrosia 1 skein (A)
 - 426 Tulips 1 skein (B)
 - 411 Mixed Berries 1 skein (C)
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

3 blocks = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm); 5 rows = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows.
- 2. Edging is worked across both ends.
- To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not cut old color. Carry colors not in use up side of the piece until next needed.

SHAWL

With A, ch 232.

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (first 3 ch count as dc), sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch, *ch 3, dc in next 3 ch, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across – you will have 32 ch-3 sps, and 33 sc at the end of this row.

Change to B.

Row 2: With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, 2 dc in first sc, *sk next 3 dc, (sc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc; rep from * across, sc in top of turning ch.

Change to C.

Row 3: With C, rep Row 2.

Change to A.

Row 4: With A, rep Row 2.

Change to B.

Rows 5-22: Rep Rows 2-4.

Change to B.

Rows 23 and 24: Rep Rows 2 and 3. Do not change to A at the end of Row 24. Cut A and B. Continue with C only.

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First Side Edging

Row 1 (RS): Working in ends of rows across side edge, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, 3 dc) in end of last row, *sk next row, (sc, ch 3, 3 dc) in end of next row; rep from * across edge, sc in corner. Fasten off.

Second Side Edging

From RS, join C with sl st in end of first row at beg of other side edge, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, 3 dc) in end of same row, *sk next row, (sc, ch 3, 3 dc) in end of next row; rep from * across edge, sc in corner. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
