# **SKILL LEVEL** – Easy+

#### <u>SIZE</u>

About 42 x 38 in. (106.5 x 96.5), before folding and seaming

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 350 Mount Rainier Tweed 8 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **GAUGE**

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-3 of Wave pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# **NOTES**

- 1. A rectangle of fabric is crocheted in Wave pattern, then folded and seamed to make the Cocoon.
- 2. Stitches of different heights create a wavy design.
- 3. Edging is worked around front edge.

#### COCOON

Ch 128.

#### **Wave Pattern**

**Row 1:** Working in back bumps of ch, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st), dc in next 4 ch, \*hdc in next 2 ch, sc in next 4 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch; rep from \* to last ch, hdc in last ch – 11 waves.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working through back loops only, hdc in first hdc, sc in next 4 dc, \*hdc in next 2 hdc, dc in next 4 sc, hdc in next 2 hdc, sc in next 4 dc; rep from \* to last st, hdc in last hdc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working through back loops only, hdc in first hdc, dc in next 4 sc, \*hdc in next 2 hdc, sc in next 4 dc, hdc in next 2 hdc, dc in next 4 sc; rep from \* to last st, hdc in last hdc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 38 in. (96.5 cm) from beg.

#### **FINISHING**

**Note:** There is no right or wrong side to the crochet piece. Just use the side you like best for the right side!

Fold piece in half to measure 21 x 38 in. (53.5 x 96.5 cm).

Place markers on each of the 21 in. (53.5 cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam sides from armhole markers down to lower edge.

#### Front Edging

Rnd 1: From RS, join yarn with a sl st in front edge at center of one long edge, ch 1, \*sc in end of next row, 2 sc in end of next row; rep from \* around to work sc evenly spaced all the way around the front opening; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, turn, working through back loops only, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st.

Rep Rnd 2 until edging measures about 4 in. (10 cm).

Weave in ends.

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd = round

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
