

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand[®] Homespun[®] Thick & Quick[®] Retreat Shawl Pattern Number: L40506

<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Width About 54 in. (137 cm) measured along top edge, not including edging

Finished Length About 24 in. (61 cm) at center

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Art. #792)
 - 211 Granite Stripes 3 skeins
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



<u>GAUGE</u>

1 pattern rep = about 3 in. (7.5 cm); 2 rows = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) over Rows 1-10 of Shawl.

Note: One pattern rep consists of one 3-dc group and the following ch-1 sp. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows in a 'Granny Stitch' pattern of 3-dc groups worked into spaces of previous row.
- 2. A 3-dc group is added at the beginning and end of each row, and two 3-dc groups are skipped at center of each row. This means that each row will have the same number of 3-dc groups. Increasing and decreasing in this manner shapes the Shawl.
- 3. Edging is worked along the 2 short side edges and lower edge.

SHAWL

Ch 76.

Row 1: Work 3 dc in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as first dc, ch 1), (ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch) 8 times, (do not ch 1), sk next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, place a marker in the sp between last two 3-dc groups made, (ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch) 8 times, ch 1, dc in last ch – you will have eighteen 3-dc groups at the end of this row.

Rows 2-11: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to marker, (do not ch 1), sk marked sp, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, move marker to sp between last two 3-dc groups made, **ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1-sp; rep from ** to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, dc) in turning ch-sp. DO NOT fasten off.

Edging

Place 9 markers along each short edge, placing the first marker at one corner, the 2nd marker at the opposite corner and the 7 remaining markers as evenly spaced as possible between the first 2 markers.

Row 1: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), do not turn, working across short edge, (tr, ch 2, tr) at first corner marker, *ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) at next marker, remove marker; rep from * to next corner marker, ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr) at corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner sps just made; working across opposite side of foundation ch, **ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) in ch at base of next 3-dc group; rep from ** to center ch-5 sp, ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr) in center ch of ch-5 sp, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner sps just made, ***ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) in ch at base of next 3-dc group; rep from ** to center ch-5 sp, ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr) in center ch of ch-5 sp, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner sps just made, ***ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) in ch at base of next 3-dc group; rep from *** to next corner marker, ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr) at corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner marker, place a marker in the center ch-2 sp of the 3 ch-2 corner sps just made, ****ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) at next marker, remove marker; rep from **** to next corner marker, (tr, ch 2, tr) at next marker, remove marker; rep from **** to next corner marker, (tr, ch 2, tr, ch 1, tr) at corner marker. **Note:** When this row is complete, you should only have markers remaining in the center ch-2 sps at the 3 lower corners.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, *working into the ch-2 sps only (skipping the ch-1 sps), (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) to marked corner ch-2 sp, ch 2, (2 dc, tr, 2 dc) in marked corner ch-2 sp and move marker to center tr just made, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * twice more, skipping the ch-1 sps, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, tr) in turning ch-sp.

Row 3: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-sp) to marked corner tr, ch 1, (2 dc, tr, 2 dc) in corner tr and move marker to center tr just made; rep from * twice more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-sp) to turning ch-sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, tr) in turning ch-sp.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, *sc in each st and ch-sp to marker corner tr, 3 sc in corner tr, remove marker; rep from * twice more, sc in each st and ch-sp to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
