

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® Simple Shells Shawl Pattern Number: L40594

## **SKILL LEVEL** – Easy

## **SIZE**

About 14 1/2 x 63 1/2 in. (37 x 161.5 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 143 Antique Rose 4 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **GAUGE**

2 pattern reps = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm); 7 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

**Note:** One pattern rep consists of one Shell and the following sc of the RS rows. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Shell Work 5 dc in indicated st.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Shawl is worked in two identical halves. Sts are worked into the opposite side of the foundation ch of first half to beg second half.
- 2. A border is worked all the way around the outer edge of Shawl.

## **SHAWL**

First Half

Ch 50.

**Row 1 (RS):** Working in back bars of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*sk next 2 ch, Shell in next ch, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across – you will have 8 Shells and 9 sc at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in first sc, ch 2, sc in center dc of next Shell, \*ch 2, dc in next sc, ch 2, sc in center dc of next Shell; rep from \* to last sc, ch 2, 2 dc in last sc – 8 sc, 11 dc, and 16 ch-2 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sk first dc, sc in next dc, \*Shell in next sc, sc in next dc; rep from \* across; leave turning ch unworked – 8 Shells and 9 sc.

Rows 4-59: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Fasten off.

**Second Half** 

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS and working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in ch at base of first sc, \*Shell in ch at base of next Shell, sc in ch at base of next sc; rep from \* across – 8 Shells and 9 sc.

Rows 2-59: Work same as Rows 2-59 of first half.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

#### **Border**

From RS, draw up a loop of yarn in center of either long side (at edge of foundation ch), ch 1, \*\*\*\*(sc, ch 3, sc) in same sp; working across long edge, sc in side of sc at end of first row, \*ch 5, sk next row, sl st in side of sc at end of next row; rep from \* to last 2 rows, ch 5, sk next row, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in side of sc at end of last row for corner; working across sts of last row, \*\*ch 3, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in center dc of next Shell, ch 3, sl st in next sc; rep from \*\* 6 more times, ch 3, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in center dc of last Shell, ch 3, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in last sc for corner; working across side edge, \*\*\*ch 5, sk next row, sl st in side of sc at end of next row; rep from \*\*\* to last 2 rows before foundation ch, ch 5, sk next row, sc in side of sc at end of first row; rep from \*\*\*\* once more; join with sl st in first sc. Weave in ends.
