


# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® Soft Shades Shawl

# **SKILL LEVEL** - Easy+

### SIZE

About 24 x 54 in. (61 x 137 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Art. #792)
  - 412 Pearls 1 skein (A)
  - 201 Coral Stripes 2 skeins (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **GAUGE**

6 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTES**

- 1. Shawl is worked in rows, changing yarn color every row.
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.
- 3. When instructed to drop a loop from hook, enlarge the loop or place it on a stitch marker or safety pin to keep it from unravelling. When instructed to pick up a dropped loop, place the loop back onto the hook and gently tighten.

# **SHAWL**

With A, ch 110.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across – you will have 28 sc and 27 ch-3 sps at the end of this row. Change to B. Drop loop of A, but do not fasten off.

**Row 2:** With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, 3 dc in each ch-3 sp across, dc in last sc – 83 dc (arranged in twenty-seven 3-dc groups and 1 dc at beg and end of row). Drop loop of B, but do not fasten off.

Row 3: Do not turn, return to beg of row just finished and insert hook in first ch (ch at base) of beg ch-3, yarn over with dropped loop of A and draw through, sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch, (sl st, ch 1, sc) in 3rd ch of beg ch, \*ch 3, sk next 3-dc group, sc in next sp between 3-dc groups; rep from \* to last 3-dc group, ch 3, sk last 3-dc group, insert hook in last dc and draw up a loop (2 loops on hook), pick up dropped loop of B (3 loops on hook) and draw through 2 loops on hook. Drop loop of A, but do not fasten off.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 24 in. (61 cm) from beg; end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

**Next Row:** With A, work same as Row 3 to last 3-dc group, ch 3, sk last 3-dc group, sc in last dc.

Fasten off B; DO NOT fasten off A.

**Edging:** With A and working in ends of rows across end of Shawl, work (ch 3, sk end of next B row, sc in end of next A row) across edge. Fasten off.

Join A with a sc to work across opposite end of Shawl and work edging across. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
sp(s) = space(s)
st(s) = stitch(es)
