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<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

About 66 in. (167.5 cm) at widest x 33 in. (84 cm) long at center

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
 - 315 Tudor 2 skeins
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size L-11 (8 mm)



<u>GAUGE</u>

Rows 1-6 of Shawl = about 22 in. (56 cm) at widest x 11 in. (28 cm) long at center.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Center-Fan (Tr, ch 1, dtr, ch 1, tr) in indicated st.

dtr (double treble/triple crochet) (Yarn over) 3 times, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times. Fan (Tr, ch 1, tr, ch 1, tr) in indicated st or sp. Shell 5 tr in indicated st or sp.

V-st (V-stitch) (Tr, ch 3, tr) in indicated st or sp.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece with increases on each row for shaping.
- 2. Since this yarn is highly textured, markers are helpful in determining which st is which. Mark the center st of each Shell, Fan, or V-st as you work, then when you work the next row you will be able to see easily which sts to work into.

SHAWL

Ch 4.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of rem 2 ch –3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, 2 hdc in first st, 3 hdc in rem 2 sts – at the end of this row you will have 9 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as first dtr, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first st, Shell in next st, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dtr in next st (center), ch 2, sk next 2 sts, Shell in next st, ch 1, dtr in last st – 2 Shells, 4 ch-sps, and 3 dtr. **Row 4:** Ch 6, turn, (Fan, tr) in first ch-sp, Fan in center st of next Shell, tr in next ch-sp, ch 2, Center-Fan in center dtr, ch 2, tr in next ch-sp, Fan in center st of next Shell, (tr, Fan, ch 1, dtr) in turning ch-sp – 5 Fans (4 regular Fans and 1 Center Fan).

Row 5: Ch 6, turn, (V-st, tr) in first ch-sp, (V-st in center st of next Fan, tr in next tr between Fans) twice, V-st in next tr, ch 2, dtr in center dtr, ch 2, V-st in next tr, (tr in next tr between Fans, V-st in center st of next Fan) twice, (tr, V-st, ch 1, dtr) in turning ch-sp – 8 V-sts.

Row 6: Ch 6, turn, tr in first st, tr in next ch-sp, *Fan in ch-sp of next V-st, tr in next tr between V-sts; rep from * to last V-st before center dtr, Fan in ch-sp of next V-st, tr in next ch-sp, ch 2, Center-Fan in center dtr, ch 2, tr in next ch-sp, Fan in ch-sp of next V-st, **tr in next tr between V-sts, Fan in ch-sp of next V-st; rep from ** to turning ch-sp, (2 tr, ch 1, dtr) in turning ch-sp – 9 Fans (8 regular Fans and 1 Center Fan).

Row 7: Ch 6, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, Shell in next tr, tr in next tr, *Shell in center st of next Fan, tr in next tr between Fans; rep from * to ch-sp before Center Fan, sk next ch-sp, Shell in next tr, ch 2, dtr in center dtr, ch 2, Shell in next tr, **tr in next tr between Fans, Shell in center st of next Fan; rep from ** across, tr in next tr following last Fan, Shell in next tr, ch 1, dtr in turning ch-sp – 12 Shells.

Row 8: Ch 6, turn, tr in first st, tr in next ch-sp, *Fan in center st of next Shell, tr in next tr between Shells; rep from * to last Shell before center dtr, Fan in center st of next Shell, tr in next ch-sp, ch 2, Center-Fan in center dtr, ch 2, tr in next ch-sp, Fan in center st of next Shell, **tr in next tr between Shells, Fan in center st of next Shell; rep from ** to turning ch-sp, (2 tr, ch 1, dtr) in turning ch-sp – 13 Fans (12 regular Fans and 1 Center Fan).

Row 9: Ch 6, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, V-st in next tr, tr in next tr, *V-st in center st of next Fan, tr in next tr between Fans; rep from * to ch-sp before Center Fan, sk next ch-sp, V-st in next tr, ch 2, dtr in center dtr, ch 2, V-st in next tr, **tr in next tr between Fans, V-st in center st of next Fan; rep from ** across, tr in next tr following last Fan, V-st in next tr, ch 1, dtr in turning ch-sp – 16 V-sts.

Rows 10-15: Rep Rows 6-9 once, then rep Rows 6 and 7 once – 28 Shells at the end of Row 15.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st and ch-sp to center dtr, 3 sc in center dtr, sc in each st and ch-sp to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
