# SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

## SIZE

Finished Hat Circumference About 21 in. (53.5 cm) Finished Hat Height About 12 in. (30.5 cm) Finished Cowl Length About 24 in. (61 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 105 Glacier Bay 1 ball (A)
  - 149 Great Smoky Mountain 1 ball
     (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **GAUGE**

12 1/2 hdc + 8 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**dc2tog (dc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased. hdc3tog (hdc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased. Puff Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Hat/Cowl is worked in 2 halves.
- 2. Both halves are worked in rnds beginning at widest end. Stitches for the Second Half are worked directly onto the First Half.
- 3. Each Half is worked with a different yarn color.
- 4. To wear as a Hat, tuck one half inside the other. To wear as a Cowl, keep piece open and use chain ties to secure around your neck.
- 5. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch of First Half into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 69, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across; join with sl st in first sc you

will have 68 hdc at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

#### **FIRST HALF**

With A, ch 68; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, taking care to not twist ch.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in next ch and each ch around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – you will have 68 hdc in this rnd.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), (dc2tog) twice, (ch 1, Puff in next st) 5 times, \*ch 1, (dc2tog) 6 times, (ch 1, Puff in next st) 5 times; rep from \* to last 6 sts, ch 1, (dc2tog) 3 times; join with sl st in first dc – 20 Puffs, 24 dc2tog, and 24 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st and ch-1 sp around; join with sl st in first sc – 68 sts.

Rnds 5-16: Rep Rnds 3 and 4 six times.

Rnd 17 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), (dc2tog) twice, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice, \*ch 1, (dc2tog) 6 times, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice; rep from \* to last 6 sts, ch 1, (dc2tog) 3 times; join with sl st in first dc – 12 Puffs, 24 dc2tog, and 16 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 4 – 52 sts.

Rnd 19 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), dc2tog, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice, \*ch 1, (dc2tog) 4 times, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice; rep from \* to last 4 sts, ch 1, (dc2tog) twice; join with sl st in first dc – 12 Puffs, 16 dc2tog, and 16 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 20:** Rep Rnd 4 – 44 sts.

Rnd 21 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), dc2tog, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice, \*ch 1, (dc2tog) 3 times, ch 1, Puff in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, Puff in next st) twice; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ch 1, dc2tog; join with sl st in first dc – 12 Puffs, 12 dc2tog, and 16 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 22:** Rep Rnd 4 – 40 sts.

Rnd 23 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (beg ch-2 and following dc count as first dc2tog), \*ch 1, sk next 3 sts, Puff in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk last 2 sts; join with sl st in first dc – 9 Puffs, 1 dc2tog, and 10 ch-1 sps. Rnd 24 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next Puff; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, sk last ch-1 sp; join with sl st in first sc – 10 sc. Rnd 25 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 1, turn, beg in first st, (sc2tog) 5 times; join with sl st in first sc – 5 sc.

Do not fasten off.

**Chain Tie:** Sk next 2 sc, sl st in next st, work ch sts to make a chain about 5 in. (12.5 cm) long. Fasten off.

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# **SECOND HALF**

From RS, working along opposite side of foundation ch of First Half, draw up a loop of B in any ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next 13 ch, hdc3tog, \*hdc in next 15 ch, hdc2tog; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 63 hdc.

Rnds 2-9: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

Rnds 10-24: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 dc in first st, \*sk next 2 sts, (sc, 2 dc) in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sk last 2 sts, sc in same st as first 2 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 21 (sc, 2 dc) groups.

Rnd 25 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, sk first st, dc2tog, \*sk next st, dc2tog; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 21 sts.
Rnd 26 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 1, turn, \*sc2tog; rep from \* to last st, sc in last st;

join with sl st in first sc - 11 sts.

Rnd 27 (Decrease Rnd): Rep Rnd 26 – 6 sts.

Do not fasten off.

**Chain Tie:** Sk next 2 sc, sl st in next st, work ch sts to make a chain about 5 in. (12.5 cm) long. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
