## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 44 x 44 in. (112 x 112 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
  - 107 Wind Cave 1 ball (A)
  - 144 Kenai Fjords 1 ball (B)
  - 156 Guadalupe Mountains 1 ball (C)
  - 178 Pinnacles 1 ball (D)
  - 173 Everglades 1 ball (E)
  - 172 Mesa Verde 1 ball (F)
  - 098 Acadia 1 ball (G)
  - 104 Zion 1 ball (H)
  - 103 Denali 1 ball (I)
  - 195 Biscayne 1 ball (J)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

1 Square = about 4 1/2 x 4 1/2 in. (11.5 x 11.5 cm).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Afghan is made from 64 Squares: 28 Single-Color Squares and 36 Two-Color Squares. Squares are sewn together following a diagram.
2. Each Square is worked in joined and turned rnds.
3. The yarn color is changed at halfway point of each Two-Color Square. To change yarn color while working the indicated ch-2: Ch 1 with old color, yarn over with new color and draw through loop on hook for 2nd ch. Proceed with new color. Do not fasten off old color until Square is complete. Carry yarn color not in use up on wrong side until next needed.
4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.
5. A Border is worked around the outside edge of the Afghan.

### **SINGLE-COLOR SQUARES (make 28 – 2 each with A, B, C, D, E, and F; 4 each with G, H, I, and J)**

Ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps (One 3-dc group between ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 2:** Turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from \* 2 more

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times, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Two 3-dc groups and 1 ch-1 sp between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 3:** Turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Three 3-dc groups and 2 ch-1 sps between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 4:** Turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Sixteen 3-dc groups, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Four 3-dc groups and 3 ch-1 sps between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

### **TWO-COLOR SQUARES (make a total of 36 in indicated color sequences and quantities)**

**Color Sequence #1 (make 12):** Use A for first color, B for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #2 (make 4):** Use C for first color, J for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #3 (make 4):** Use D for first color, G for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #4 (make 2):** Use A for first color, J for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #5 (make 2):** Use B for first color, G for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #6 (make 2):** Use C for first color, G for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #7 (make 2):** Use D for first color, I for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #8 (make 2):** Use E for first color, J for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #9 (make 2):** Use E for first color, H for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #10 (make 2):** Use F for first color, I for 2nd color.

**Color Sequence #11 (make 2):** Use F for first color, H for 2nd color.

With first color, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** With first color, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, 3 dc in ring, ch 2 and change to 2nd color, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) twice; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps (One 3-dc group between ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 2:** With 2nd color, turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2 and change to first color, 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Two 3-dc groups and 1 ch-1 sp between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 3:** With first color, turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 2 and change to 2nd color, 3 dc in same corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3

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dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Three 3-dc groups and 2 ch-1 sps between corner ch-2 sps).

**Rnd 4:** With 2nd color, turn, sl st in 2 ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 2 and change to first color, 3 dc in same corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Sixteen 3-dc groups, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Four 3-dc groups and 3 ch-1 sps between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew Squares together following diagram.

### **Border**

**Rnd 1 (WS):** From WS, join I with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp of Afghan, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same corner ch-2 sp; working in each ch-1 sp and first ch-2 sp at seams between Squares (skip the 2nd ch-2 sp at seams), \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-sp) along edge to next corner ch-2 sp of Afghan, ch 1, (3 dc ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-sp) along edge to first corner ch-2 sp of Afghan, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 2 (RS):** From RS, join J with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 sc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-1 sp) along edge to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 sc, ch 2, 3 sc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-1 sp) along edge to first corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 sc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 3 (WS):** From WS, join H with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) along edge to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) along edge to first corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** With G, rep Rnd 2.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 5:** With E, rep Rnd 3.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 6:** With F, rep Rnd 2.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** With C, rep Rnd 3.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 8:** With A, rep Rnd 2.

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Fasten off.

**Rnd 9:** With D, rep Rnd 3.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 10:** With B, rep Rnd 2.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

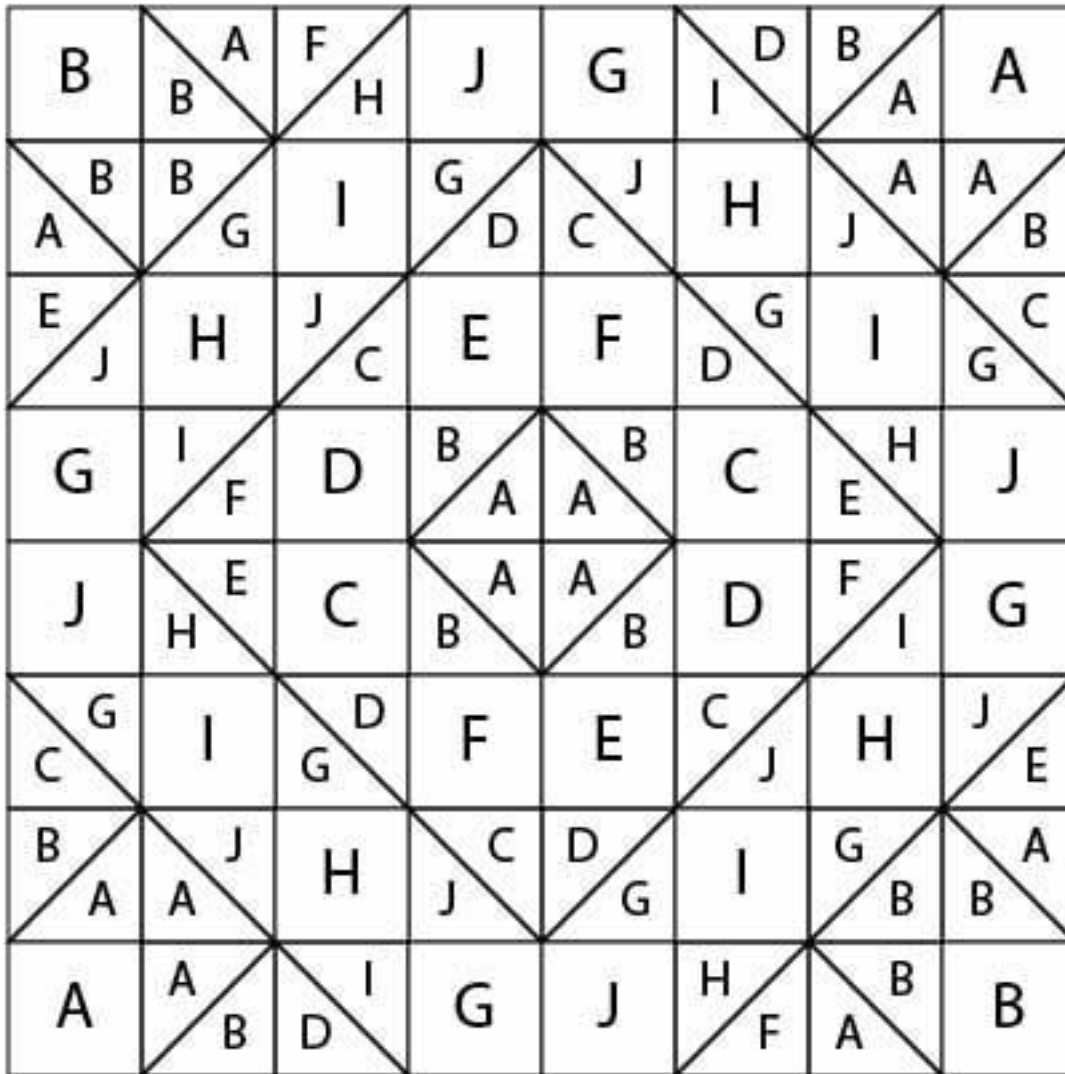
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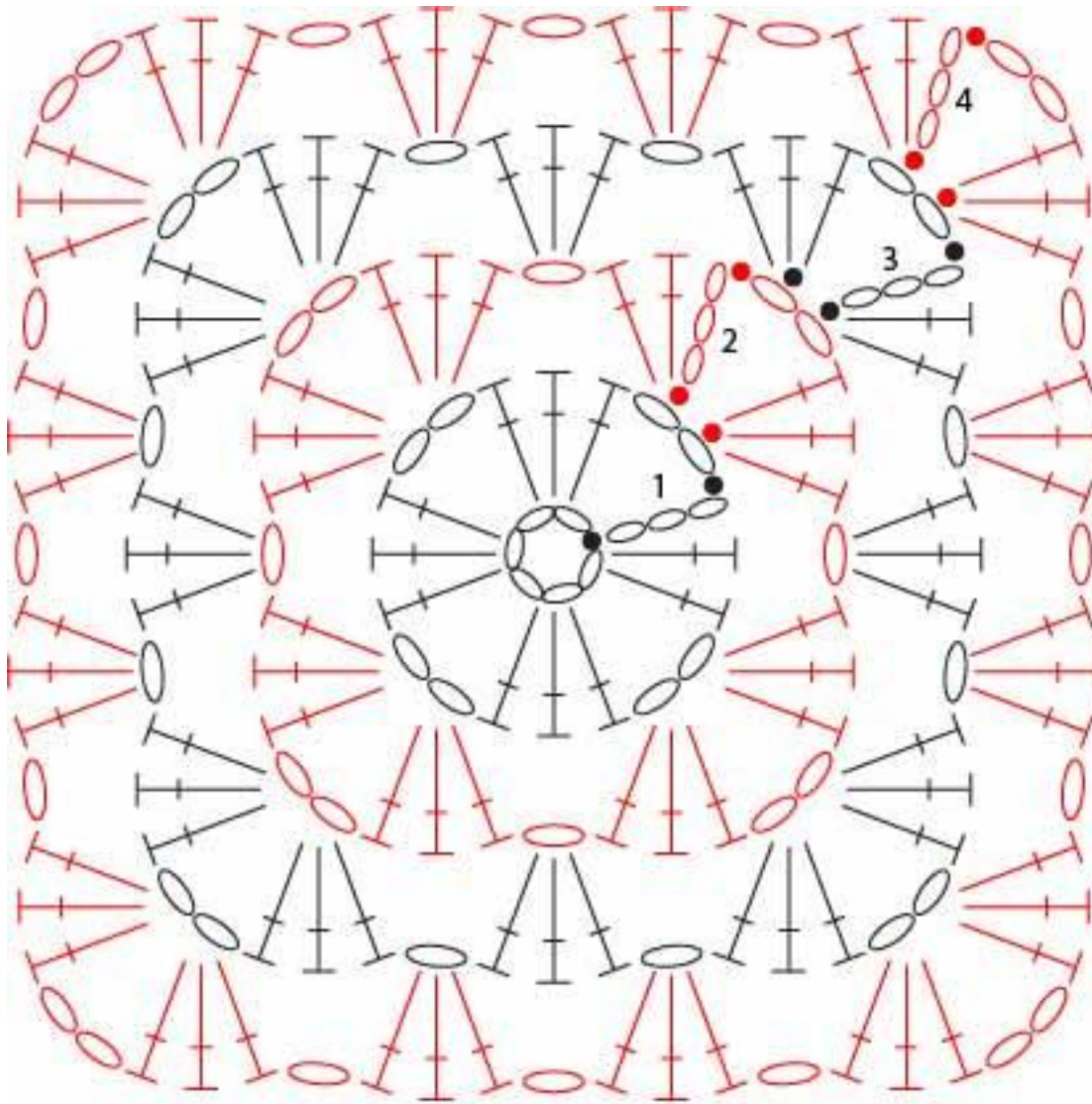
