**Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball**  
**Easy Eyelet Scarf**  
Pattern Number: L60271



## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 17 x 54 in. (43 x 137 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball (Art. #828)
  - 306 Graceful Green 1 ball
  - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

#### **Yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

### **NOTES**

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in a loose gauge and an easy eyelet pattern.
2. The edges of the Scarf will roll gently.

### **SCARF**

Cast on 64 sts.

Beginning with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 12 rows.

**Row 1 Eyelet Row (RS):** K7, \*yo, k2tog, k10; rep from \* to last 9 sts, yo, k2tog, k7.

**Rows 2-12:** Work in St st.

Rep Rows 1-12 for 19 more times – when you've finished all these repeats, you'll have 20 Eyelet rows and your Scarf will end with 11 rows of St st.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

If desired, you can block your Scarf – just dampen it with a spray bottle of water, then lay flat to dry. Blocking will help even out your stitches.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch
