- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 139 Rose Shocking 1 ball (A)
- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
 - 208 Phoenix Azalea 1 ball (B)
 - 102 Honolulu Pink 1 ball (C)
 - 216 Anchorage Ice 1 ball (D)
 - 302 Aspen Tweed 1 ball (E)
- Martha Stewart Crafts^{TM/MC} Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver TM Starter Kit



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Fiberfill stuffing

NOTES

- 1. Pillow is meant to inspire your creativity! Follow the row by row instructions or make changes to make the pillow your own!
- To change yarn color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail. Begin weaving with the new color, leaving a long yarn tail. These tails can be woven in later.
- The manual includes the information you need to complete your project. Be sure to visit Lionbrand.com for step by step videos of DIY WeaverTM techniques.

First Side

Loom Set-Up

Following manual instructions, insert 28 standard pegs across the top row of the loom base and 28 pegs across bottom row of loom base – 56 pegs placed for warp.

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 56 pegs with A.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

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With B, work 13 rows.

With E, work 13 rows.

With D, work 13 rows.

With E, work 5 rows.

With C, work 9 rows.

With B, work 5 rows.

With E, work 9 rows.

With D, weave remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

Second Side

Loom Set-Up

Following manual instructions, insert 28 standard pegs across the top row of the loom base and 28 pegs across bottom row of loom base – 56 pegs placed for warp.

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 56 pegs with A.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

With D, work 10 rows.

With C, work 9 rows.

With E, work 12 rows.

With B, work 8 rows.

With E, work 6 rows.

With C, work 10 rows.

With D, weave the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

FINISHING

Assembly

Hold sides with wrong sides together. With A threaded into blunt needle, whipstitch sides together. When you have almost finished sewing, stuff Pillow, then finish sewing closed.
