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SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

One Size

Finished Width About 38 in. (96.5 cm), after folding and seaming **Finished Length** About 22 1/2 in. (57 cm), after folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Ice Cream® (Art. #923)
 - 212 Coffee 4 balls
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

Twelve 2-dc groups (24 sts) + 13 1/2 rows = about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



- 1. Poncho is worked in 2 identical Halves.
- 2. Halves are joined together with crocheted cords then piece is folded to make the Poncho.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

HALF (make 2)

Ch 72.

Row 1 (RS): Work 2 dc in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), 2 dc in next ch, *sk next 2 ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have thirty-four 2-dc groups and 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, *sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 5-46: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, *sk next st, dc in next 24 sts, sk next st, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts; rep from * once more, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch – Ten 2-dc groups, two 24-dc groups, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Rows 47 and 48: Rep Row 2 twice.

Rows 49-90: Rep Row 5 forty-two times.

Rows 91-94: Rep Row 2 four times.

Fasten off.

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CORDS (make 2)

Make a chain about 60 in. (152.5 cm) long. Fasten off.

FINISHING


Lay Halves side by side on a flat surface, with long edges together at center. Fold one cord in half. Beg about 17 in. (43 cm) from one short edge and working as if lacing a shoe, lace cord through spaces at ends of rows of both Halves down to lower edge. At lower edge, tie ends securely in a knot or bow. Leaving about 11 in. (28 cm) open at center for neck opening, rep to lace 2nd cord beg about 17 in. (43 cm) from other short edge.

Weave in ends.


