


Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour® 24-7 Cotton Snowflakes

Pattern Number: L60385

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Snowflake measure about 11-14 in. (28-35.5 cm) at widest

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour (Art. #861)
 - 100 Diamond 1 ball (A)
- Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton (Art. #761)
 - 100 White 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Fabric stiffener (Aleene's Fabric Stiffener or Plaid Stiffy, etc.)

MATERIALS NOTE

Yarn amounts are sufficient to make all 5 Snowflakes.

GAUGE

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

STITCH EXPLANATION

CI (2 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1. Each Snowflake is worked in joined rnds with RS always facing.
- 2. Snowflakes are made with 1 strand each of A and B held together.
- 3. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included stitch diagrams.

SNOWFLAKE I

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 12 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), dc in next st, *ch 4, dc in next st; rep from * around, ch 4; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-7 – 12 dc and 12 ch-4 sps.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *(2 sc, ch 4, 2 sc) in next ch-4 sp, 2 sc in next ch-4 sp, (ch 6, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch) 3 times (3 spikes made), ch 4, Cl in 3rd ch from

hook, ch 2, sl st in next ch (last ch of the ch-4), sl st in base of last spike made; (ch 5, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch (spike made), sl st in next ch between spikes, sl st in base of next spike) twice, ch 5, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch (spike made), sl st in next ch following spikes, 2 sc in same ch-4 sp of Rnd 2 (branch made); rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 6 spikes and 1 Cl on each of 6 branches.

Fasten off.

SNOWFLAKE II

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 7 (counts as sc, ch 6), 2 sc in ring, *ch 6, 2 sc in ring; rep from * 3 more times, ch 6, sc in ring; join with sl st in first ch of beg ch-7 – you will have 12 sc and 6 ch-6 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 ch of beg ch-7, ch 3 (counts as dc), (dc, ch 6, 2 dc) in first ch-6 sp (first branch made), (2 dc, ch 6, 2 dc) in next 5 ch-6 sps; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – 6 branches.

Rnd 3: SI st in next dc, *(sc, ch 4, sc, ch 6, sc, ch 4, sc) in next ch-6 sp, ch 3; rep from * around; join with sI st in first sc.

Rnd 4: SI st in first 2 ch of first ch-4 sp, 2 sc in same ch-4 sp, *(2 sc, ch 4, sc, ch 6, sc, ch 4, 2 sc) in next ch-6 sp (3 ch-loops made), 2 sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, 2 sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * 4 more times, (2 sc, ch 4, sc, ch 6, sc, ch 4, 2 sc) in next ch-6 sp (3 ch-loops made), 2 sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, sk last ch-3 sp; join with sI st in first sc – 3 ch-loops on each of 6 branches. Fasten off.

SNOWFLAKE III

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 12 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, *ch 12, sl st in 7th ch from hook, sc in next 5 ch **, sc in next 2 sc of Rnd 1 (branch made); rep from * to last sc ending last rep at **, sc in last sc of Rnd 1; join with sl st in first sc – 6 branches.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc in 3rd ch on right side edge of next branch, ch 2, 8 sc in ch-6 sp at top of same branch, ch 2, sk next 2 sc of same branch, dc in next sc of same branch, sk last 2 sc of same branch, sk next sc of Rnd 2 **, dc in next sc (between branches); rep from * around ending last rep at **; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4: SI st in next dc, sI st in next 2 ch, sc in next sc, *ch 4, sc in next 3 sc, ch 6, sI st in 5th ch from hook (ch-6 loop made), ch 8, sI st in 7th ch from hook (ch-8 loop made), ch 10, sI st in 9th ch from hook and next ch (ch-10 loop made), sI st in base of last ch-8 loop made, ch 7, sI st in next ch between loops, sI st in base of next ch-6 loop, ch 5, sI st in next ch following ch-6 loop, sc in next 3 sc, ch 4, sc in next sc, ch 2 **, sc in first sc of next branch; rep from * around ending last rep at **; join with sI st in first sc – 5 ch-loops on each of 6 branches.

Fasten off.

SNOWFLAKE IV

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), dc in ring, (ch 4, dc in ring) 10 times, ch 4; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-7 – you will have 12 dc and 12 ch-4 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 ch of beg ch-7, ch 9 (counts as sc, ch 8), sc in next ch-4 sp, *ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 8, sc in next ch-4 sp (branch made); rep from * 4 more times, ch 4; join with sI st in first ch of beg ch-7 – 6 ch-8 branches.

Rnd 3: *3 sc in next ch-8 sp, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook and next ch (ch-loop made), sc in same ch-8 sp, ch 9, sl st in 7th ch from hook and next 2 ch (ch-loop made), sc in same ch-8 sp, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook and next ch, 3 sc in same ch-8 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 6, sl st in 5th ch from hook and next ch, sc in same ch-4 sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 3 ch-loops on each of 6 branches and 1 ch-loop between branches.

Fasten off.

SNOWFLAKE V

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in ring, (ch 8, sc in ring) 5 times, ch 8; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 6 sc and 6 ch-8 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: SI st in first 3 ch of first ch-8, ch 1, (sc, ch 8, sc) in same ch-8 sp (first branch made), *ch 3, (sc, ch 8, sc) in next ch-8 sp (branch made); rep from * around, ch 3; join with sI st in first sc – 6 branches.

Rnd 3: SI st in first 3 ch of first ch-8, ch 1, (sc, ch 10, sc) in same ch-8 sp, *ch 6, (sc, ch 10, sc) in next ch-8 sp; rep from * around, ch 6; join with sI st in first sc.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next ch-10 sp, (ch 4, sI st in 4th ch from hook, sc in same ch-10 sp) twice (2 ch-loops made), ch 6, sI st in 6th ch from hook (ch-loop made), (sc in same ch-10 sp, ch 4, sI st in 4th ch from hook) twice, 2 sc in same ch-10 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-6 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in first sc – 5 ch-loops on each of 6 branches.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Following package directions, apply stiffener, then allow to dry.

ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
tog = together
