SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Width (lower edge) About 33 1/2 in. (85 cm)

Finished Height About 9 1/2 in. (24 cm), including collar

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun (Art. #790)
 - 381 Barley 1 skein
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

PATTERN STITCH

Seed st (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep Row 1 for Seed st.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

1. Capelet is worked in one piece beg at lower edge.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

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CAPELET

With circular needle, loosely cast on 101 sts.

Rows 1-4: Working back and forth in rows on circular needle, work in Seed st for 4 rows.

Row 5 (RS): Work in Seed st as established over first 4 sts (for border), place marker (pm), k to last 4 sts, pm, work in Seed st as established to end of row (for border).

Row 6: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker (sm), p to next marker, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Continue as established, keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st and remaining sts in St st (k on RS, p on WS), and slipping markers as you come to them, until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row 1 (RS): Work in Seed st to marker, sm, k2tog, (k7, k2tog) 9 times, k8, k2tog, sm, work in Seed st to end of row – you will have 90 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Work in Seed st to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Rep last row until piece measures about 5 in. (12.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row 2 (RS): Work in Seed st to marker, sm, (k2, k2tog) 20 times, k2, sm, work in Seed st to end of row – 70 sts.

Next Row: Work in Seed st to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Eyelet Row (RS): Work in Seed st to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k2) 15 times, k2tog, yo, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Next Row: Work in Seed st to marker, remove marker, p2tog, p to next marker, remove marker, work in Seed st to end of row – 69 sts.

Next Row: Work in Seed st across all sts.

Rep last row until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg.

Bind off in Seed st.

FINISHING

Cord

With crochet hook, make a chain about 45 in. (114.5 cm) long.

Fasten off.

Weave Cord through holes in Eyelet Row.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

pm = place marker

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sm = slip marker

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side

yo = yarn over
