

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Homespun® Zigzag Hat and Cowl Pattern Number: L40120

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SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

<u>Hat</u>

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes. Cowl

Finished Circumference About 65 in. (165 cm) Finished Height 9 in. (23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
 - 426 Tulips 1 skein (A)
 - 386 Grape 1 skein (B)
 - 368 Montana Sky 1 skein (C)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 ripple = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm), measured from peak to peak. 9 1/2 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Hat is worked in 2 parts: Band and Crown (top of Hat). Band is worked back and forth in rows, then ends of Band are sewn tog to make a ring. Crown is worked in rnds beg along one edge of finished Band.
- 2. Cowl is worked in 2 sections back and forth in rows, then sewn tog.
- 3. A ripple crochet pattern is used in Band of Hat and for Cowl. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 4. The yarn color is changed as specified in instructions. To change color when working Band, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all sts on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color. To change color when working Crown, fasten off old color and join new color as instructed.

<u>HAT</u>

Band

With A, ch 18.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 2 sc in last ch – 1 ripple.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in last st.

Change to B.

Rows 7-12: With B, rep Row 2.

Change to C.

Rows 13-36: Continue to rep Row 2, working 6 rows each with C, A, B, and C. At the end of Row 36, fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Use yarn tail to sew last row to first row to make a ring.

Crown (Top of Hat)

Rnd 1 (RS): Join B with sc anywhere along one edge of finished Band. Work 47 sc evenly spaced around edge; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc.

Rnds 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 40 sts at the end of this rnd.

Fasten off.

Rnd 6: From RS, join C with sc in any st, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 32 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 24 sts.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 16 sts. Fasten off.

Rnd 11: From RS, join A with sc in any st, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, *sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 8 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through rem sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

COWL

First Section

With A. ch 114.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 2 sc in next ch; rep from * across – 7 ripples.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, *sc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * across.

At the end of Row 4, change to B.

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Rows 5-16: With B, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

Second Section

With C, ch 82.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 2 sc in next ch; rep from * across – 5 ripples.

Rows 2-15: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, *sc in next 7 sts, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * across.

At the end of Row 15, change to A.

Row 16: With A, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew ends of First and Second Sections tog to make Cowl. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

rem = remain(ing)(s)

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together
