

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Homespun® Ripped Hooded Cowl Pattern Number: L40080

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference at Lower Edge About 30 in. (76 cm) Finished Height About 19 in. (48 cm) from lower edge to top of hood

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun(Art. #790)
 - 408 Wild Fire 1 skein (A)
 - 381 Barley 1 skein (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 ripple = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) measured from peak to peak. 7 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

RIPPLE PATTERN

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 2 ch,* 3 sc in next ch, sc in each of next 3 ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in each of next 3 ch; rep from * to last 4 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in each of next 3 ch.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in each of next 3 sts, * 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st.

Rows 3-5: Rep Row 2.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, skip first st, dc in each of next 3 sts, * 3 dc in next st, dc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, dc in last st.

Rep Rows 2-6 for Ripple pattern.

NOTES

- Cowl is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating 3-st "peaks" and skipped st "valleys". Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned. 3 sts are worked into the center st of peaks, and sts are skipped over valleys.
- 3. Do not cut yarn, carry unused color along side edge of piece.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 10 rows with A, * 2 rows with B, 4 rows with A; rep from * once, then work 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A.

HOODED COWL

With A, ch 89.

Row 1: With A, work Row 1 of Ripple pattern across – 10 ripples at the end of this row.

Rows 2-14: Continue in Ripple pattern, changing color following Stripe Sequence.

Begin Hood

Row 15: Keeping to Stripe Sequence, work next row of Ripple pattern over first 7 ripples, leave rem 3 ripples unworked for upper front edge of Cowl.

Note: Rows 16-33 are worked over the 7 ripples ONLY.

Rows 16-26: Continue in Ripple pattern over the 7 ripples, changing color following Stripe Sequence.

Note: Row 27 will be worked over parts of Row 26, you will be skipping over 2 valleys of Row 26 when working the next row. Be sure to keep remaining peaks and valleys aligned.

Row 27: With A, ch 1, turn, skip first st, * sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, skip 2 sts; rep from * once; sc in next 3 sts, sk next 9 sts (1 whole ripple), sc in next st (top of next ripple), sk next 9 sts (1 whole ripple), sc in next 3 sts, skip 2 sts (aligns with previous valleys), sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st.

Row 28: With A, ch 1, turn, skip first st, *sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts; rep from * once; sc in each of next 5 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sts in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st. Change to B.

Row 29: With B, ch 1, turn, skip first st, *sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts; rep from * once; dc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st.

Row 30: With B, ch 1, turn, skip first st, *sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts; rep from * once; sc in each of next 3 st, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st.

Row 31: With B, ch1, turn, skip 1 st, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next st (center st in previous 3 st peak), sc2tog(third st in previous 3-st peak and first st in next 3-st peak), sc in next st (third st in 3-st peak), sc in each of next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st.

Row 32: With B, ch 3, turn, skip first st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, skip 1 st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, skip 2 sts, dc in next st, skip 3 sts, slip st in next st, skip 1 st, dc in next st, skip 2 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, skip 1 st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, skip 1 st, dc in last st.

Row 33: With B, ch1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold hood in half and sew rem top seam closed. Sew ripple edges tog on Rows 27 and 31.

Sew side seam to make Cowl.

From RS, join B with sl st anywhere along lower edge of Cowl. Work sc evenly spaced around lower edge, join with sl st in first sc. Rep around upper edge of Cowl and front edge of hood.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
