

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Heartland Granny Squares Scarf and Earflap Hat

Pattern Number: L40040
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SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZES

<u>Hat</u>

Finished Circumference About 17 1/2 in. (44.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Height About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

Scarf

About 7 x 48 in. (18 x 122 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland (Art. #136)
 - 153 Black Canyon 1 ball (A)
 - 098 Acadia 1 ball (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 x 4 in. (5 x 10 cm) piece of heavy cardboard

GAUGE

One Square = about 3 1/2 x 3 1/2 in. (9 x 9 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

FPTR (front post treble crochet) Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times. Skip st behind the FPTR.

NOTES

- 1. Hat is made from 13 pieces: 10 Squares, 1 Pentagon Motif and 2 Earflaps. All pieces are sewn tog to make the Hat.
- 2. Scarf is made from 18 Squares sewn tog following the Assembly Diagram.

HAT

SQUARE I (make 5)

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc in this rnd and all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 12 dc (four 3-dc groups). Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, draw up a loop of B in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 sp, *dc in each st to next ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 28 dc (7 dc across each edge between corner ch-2 sps). Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, draw up a loop of A in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-sp, *dc in next 3 sts, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Rnd 1, dc in next 3 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, dc in next 3 sts, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Rnd 1, dc in next 3 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 44 sts (11 sts across each edge between corner ch-2 sps). Fasten off.

SQUARE II (make 5)

Make same as Square I, working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with A, and Rnd 3 with B.

PENTAGON MOTIF

With B, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc in this rnd and all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 4 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch -5 ch-2 sps and 15 dc (five 3-dc groups). Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, draw up a loop of A in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 sp, *dc in each st to next ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from * 3 more times, dc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 35 dc (7 dc across each edge between corner ch-2 sps). Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, draw up a loop of B in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-sp, *dc in next 3 sts, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Rnd 1, dc in next 3 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * 3 more times, dc in next 3 sts, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Rnd 1, dc in next 3 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 55 sts (11 sts across each edge between corner ch-2 sps). Fasten off.

EARFLAPS (make 2)

Note: To change color while working earflaps, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

With A, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 in this row and all following rows), (3 dc in ring, ch 2) twice, dc in ring and change to B-3 ch-2 sps and 8 dc (two 3-dc groups and a dc at beg and end of row).

Row 2: With B, ch 5, turn, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-2 sp and change to A – 3 ch-2 sps and 16 dc.

Row 3: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Row 1, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc, FPTR around center dc of 3-dc group of Row 1, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in last ch-2 sp – 1 ch-2 sp and 24 sts. Do not change color. **Row 4:** With A, ch 1, turn, work 10 sc evenly spaced across to ch-2 sp, 4 sc in ch-2 sp, work 10 sc evenly spaced across to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING HAT

Sew all 5 Square I's into a strip. Rep with all 5 Square II's. Sew one long edge of strips tog to make a rectangle. Sew short ends of rectangle tog to make a tube. Sew edges of Pentagon Motif to open edge of Square II strip for top of Hat. Sew straight edge of one Earflap to lower edge of Hat, beg at center of one Square and ending at center of next Square. Sew straight edge of 2nd Earflap to lower edge of Hat, beg at center of next Square following first Earflap. The 2 halves of Squares skipped between Earflaps are at back of Hat.

Earflap Ties

From RS, join 2 strands of A held tog with sl st in tip of one Earflap, ch 40. Fasten off. Rep for tie on 2nd Earflap.

Tassel (make 2)

Wrap A and B around 2 in. (5 cm) side of cardboard 20 times. Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) length of A and thread doubled into large-eyed blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut a 12 in. (30.5 cm) length of A and wrap tightly around loops 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot to form Tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends onto needle and weave ends to center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. Tie one tassel to end of each Earflap tie.

SCARF

SQUARE I (make 9)

Make same as Square I of Hat.

SQUARE II (make 9)

Make same as Square II of Hat.

FINISHING SCARF

Sew Squares tog into pairs and then into a strip, following Assembly Diagram. Weave in ends.

tog = together

beg = begin(ning)(s)
ch = chain
ch-sp = chain space previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
sp(s) = space(s)
st(s) = stitch(es)
