

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Homespun® Bobble Ripple Cowl Pattern Number: L40079

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 32 in. (81 cm) Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun(Art. #790)
 - 426 Tulips 1 skein
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 ripple = about 4 in. (10 cm), measured from peak to peak. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Bobble (worked all in one stitch) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), *yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook; rep from * once more, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1. Cowl is worked in joined rnds beg at lower edge. Turn at beg of each rnd.
- 2. Cowl is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern consists of alternating 3-st "peaks" and skipped st "valleys." Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each rnd aligned. 3 sts are worked into the center st of peaks, and sts are skipped over valleys.
- 3. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 4. When working in ripple crochet, your piece may not lie flat until you've worked a few rnds.

COWL

Loosely ch 104. Being careful not to twist ch; join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch as joining, *sc in next 5 ch, sk 2 ch, sc in next 5 ch, 3 sc in next ch; rep from * to last 12 ch, sc in next 5 ch, sk 2 ch, sc in next 5 ch, sc again in same ch as first sc; join with sl st in first sc – 104 sc (8 ripples with 5 sts between peaks and valleys) at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 3, turn, (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st as joining and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook, sc in same st, *sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, (sc, bobble, sc) in next st; rep from * to last 12 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sc in same st as as joining; join with sl st in top of bobble.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in same st as joining, *sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next st (top of bobble); rep from * to last 12 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sc in same st as first sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 4 and 5: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in same st as joining, *sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next st; rep from * to last 12 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sc in same st as first sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 6-13: Rep Rnds 2-5.

Rnds 14 and 15: Rep Rnds 2 and 3.

Rnd 16: Rep Rnd 2.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
