SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 20 x 62 in. (51 x 157.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homespun® (Art. #790)
 - 404 Lagoon 2 skeins (A)
 - 368 Montana Sky 1 skein (B)
 - 341 Windsor 1 skein (C)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

2 ripples = about 13 in. (33 cm), measured from peak to peak.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating 3-st "peaks" and skipped st "valleys". Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned. 3 sts are worked into the center st of peaks, and sts are skipped over valleys.
3. When working in ripple crochet, your piece may not lay flat until you've worked a few rows.
4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 4 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 4 rows with A.

SHAWL

With A, ch 162.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next 5 ch, sk 1 ch, sc in next 9 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 9 ch, sk 1 ch, sc in next 5 ch**, 3 sc in next ch; rep

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from * three times, then from * to **, 2 sc in last ch – 10 ripples at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as dc in this row or in any of the following rows), turn, work 2 dc into first sc, *dc in next 5 sc, sk 2 sc, dc in next 9 sc, 3 dc in next sc, dc in next 9 sc, sk 2 sts, dc in next 5 sc **, 3 dc in next sc; rep from * three times, then from * to **, 2 dc in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first dc, *sc in next 5 dc, sk 2 dc, sc in next 9 dc, 3 sc in next dc, sc in next 9 dc, sk 2 dc, sc in next 5 dc**, 3 sc in next dc; rep from * three times, then from * to **, 2 sc in last dc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3, changing color following Stripe Sequence, until all 26 rows of Stripe Sequence have been worked.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Bobbles (make 5)

With C, ch 9.

*Yarn over, insert hook in 4th ch from hook, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook; rep from * 6 times more in same ch, yarn over, draw through all 8 loops on hook, ch 1 and tighten, sl st in base of bobble. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Use yarn tails to tie a Bobble to the peak of each large ripple along last row of Shawl.

Weave in ends.
