

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Quick Knit Triangle Cowl Pattern Number: L40625



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 58 in. (147.5 cm) Finished Height About 7 in. (18 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Art. #640)
 - 135 Spice 1 ball (A)
 - 147 Eggplant 1 ball (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

8 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter st (k every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

w&t (wrap and turn) A technique used to ensure that a small hole doesn't form at the end of a short row.

- 1. Slip next st as if to purl.
- 2. Bring yarn between needles to front. Take care not to wrap the yarn over a needle, this would create a new st.
- 3. Slip same st back to left needle.
- 4. Turn work and bring yarn in position for next st. This will place a yarn wrap around the st.
- 5. When next working the wrapped st, lift the wrap onto the left hand needle and knit it tog with the st.

NOTES

- 1. Cowl is worked as a rectangle, then seamed to make the Cowl.
- 2. Short rows are used to create the color design.
- When changing yarn color, B is always cut when each B color pattern is completed; A is dropped and carried along the side edge of the piece until next needed.

COWL

With A, cast on 15 sts.

Rows 1 and 2: Sl 1, k to end of row.

Row 3 (RS): SI 1, k11, w&t.

Row 4: K to end of row.

Row 5: SI 1, k8, w&t.

Row 6: K to end of row.

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Row 7: Sl 1, k5, w&t.

Row 8: K to end of row.

Row 9: SI 1, k2, w&t.

Row 10: K to end of row.

Drop A and join B.

When working wrapped sts on Rows 11-20, lift the wrap onto the left hand needle and knit it together with the st.

Row 11: With B, sl 1, k to end of row.

Row 12: SI 1, k2, w&t.

Row 13: K to end of row.

Row 14: SI 1, k5, w&t.

Row 15: K to end of row.

Row 16: SI 1, k8, w&t.

Row 17: K to end of row.

Row 18: Sl 1, k11, w&t.

Row 19: K to end of row.

Row 20: SI 1, k to end of row.

Cut B and pick up A.

Rep Rows 1-20 until piece measures about 58 in. (147.5 cm) from beginning, ending with a Row 20 as the last row you work. Do not cut B at the end of the last rep.

Bind off with B.

FINISHING

Sew cast on edge to bound off edge to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.

rep(s) = repeat(s)

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)
