

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Quick Striped Lap Blanket Pattern Number: L40622

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 36 x 36 in. (91.5 x 91.5 cm), including edging.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Art. #640)
 - 503 Granite 4 balls (A)
 - 146 Fig 1 ball (B)
 - 133 Pumpkin 1 ball (C)
 - 135 Spice 1 ball (D)
 - 131 Grass 1 ball (E)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

9 1/2 sts + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row). One Block = about 8 1/2 x 8 1/2 in. (21.5 x 21.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st - 1 st increased.

NOTES

- Lap Blanket is made from 16 Squares. Each Square is worked in Garter st, changing color to make stripes. Carry color not in use along side of piece until next needed.
- 2. Squares are sewn tog following a diagram. Edging is worked around outside edge of the assembled Blanket.
- A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts in edging. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

SQUARE I (make 4)

With A, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 32 rows, changing color as follows: Work (8 rows with A, 8 rows with B) twice.
Bind off.

SQUARE II (make 4)

With A, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 32 rows, changing color as follows: Work (8 rows with A, 8 rows with C) twice. Bind off.

SQUARE III (make 4)

With A, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 32 rows, changing color as follows: Work (8 rows with A, 8 rows with D) twice. Bind off.

SQUARE IV (make 4)

With A, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 32 rows, changing color as follows: Work (8 rows with A, 8 rows with E) twice. Bind off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew into 4 strips of 4 Squares each. Sew strips tog to make Blanket.

Left Side Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS with B, beg at top corner of left side edge, pick up and k80 sts spaced as evenly as possible across edge.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Kfb. k to last st. kfb – 82 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: Kfb, k to last st, kfb - 84 sts.

Row 6: Knit. Cut B.

With A, bind off.

Right Side Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS with D, beg at lower corner of right side edge, pick up and k80 sts spaced as evenly as possible across edge.

Rows 2-6: Work same as Rows 2-6 of left side edging. Cut D.

With A, bind off.

Lower Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS with C, beg at corner of lower edge, pick up and k80 sts spaced as evenly as possible across edge.

Rows 2-6: Work same as Rows 2-6 of left side edging. Cut C.

With A, bind off.

Top Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS with E, beg at corner of top edge, pick up and k80 sts spaced as evenly as possible across edge.

Rows 2-6: Work same as Rows 2-6 of left side edging. Cut E.

With A, bind off.

Sew sides of edgings tog.

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Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)(s) k = knit rep = repeat RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es) tog = together
