## **SKILL LEVEL – Beginner**

### **SIZE**

About 7 x 66 in. (18 x 167.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Jeans (Art. #505)
  - 108 Brand New 1 ball (A)
  - 109 Stonewash 1 ball (B)
  - 105 Faded 1 ball (C)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row).  
**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Two Strips are worked separately, then sewn together to make the Scarf.
2. Each Strip is worked with just one stitch – the knit stitch!
3. The yarn color is changed to make stripes and blocks of color.

### **FIRST STRIP**

With B, cast on 16 sts.

#### **Section I**

With B, work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for 24 rows.

#### **Section II**

In this section, you do not need to cut your yarn between color changes, just carry the color not in use up the side edge of your piece.

With C, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

With B, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Repeat these last 4 rows until you have worked 24 rows total in Section II.

#### **Section III**

With C, work in Garter st for 24 rows.

#### **Section IV**

With A, work in Garter st for 24 rows.

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### **Section V**

In this section, you do not need to cut your yarn between color changes, just carry the color not in use up the side edge of your piece.

With B, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

With A, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Repeat these last 4 rows until you have worked 24 rows total in Section V.

Repeat Sections I-V for 3 more times (you will have worked Sections I-V of First Strip for a total of 4 times).

Bind off.

### **SECOND STRIP**

With A, cast on 16 sts.

### **Section I**

In this section, you do not need to cut your yarn between color changes, just carry the color not in use up the side edge of your piece.

With A, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

With B, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Repeat these last 4 rows until you have worked 24 rows total in Section I.

### **Section II**

With A, work in Garter st for 24 rows.

### **Section III**

In this section, you do not need to cut your yarn between color changes, just carry the color not in use up the side edge of your piece.

With C, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

With A, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Repeat these last 4 rows until you have worked 24 rows total in Section III.

### **Section IV**

With C, work in Garter st for 24 rows.

### **Section V**

With B, work in Garter st for 24 rows.

Repeat Sections I-V for 3 more times (you will have worked Sections I-V of Second Strip for a total of 4 times).

Bind off.

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## **FINISHING**

Sew Strips together along long sides.

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

st(s) = stitch(es)
