

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Jeans® San Antonio Vest

SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZE

Finished Back Width About 20 in. (51 cm) Finished Length About 36 in. (91.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans (Art. #505)
 - 121 Top Stitch 2 balls (A)
 - 153 Stovepipe 1 ball (B)
 - 108 Brand New 2 balls (C)
 - 110 Classic 2 balls (D)
 - 109 Stonewash 2 balls (E)
 - 105 Faded 2 balls (F)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

GAUGE

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

PATTERN STITCH

Seed Stitch (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: P the knit sts and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES

- 1. Vest is worked in 3 pieces: Back/Upper Fronts, and 2 Lower Fronts.
- 2. Vest uses a unique construction refer to the diagrams before beginning to clarify construction.
- 3. Each piece is worked in blocks of different yarn colors and pattern sts.
- 4. After the first block of a piece is worked, sts are picked up along one edge of previous block(s) to beg the next block.
- 5. The circular needle is used only for the armhole edging.
- 6. Pieces are sewn together following a diagram and leaving armholes open.

BACK/UPPER FRONTS

Block 1

With E, cast on 37 sts.



Work in Rev St st (p on RS, k on WS) until Block 1 measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS (knit) row as the last row you work. Bind off.

Block 2

Note: When working Block 2, there is no need to cut yarn between color changes. Simply carry the unused color along side edge of the block.

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with A, pick up and k91 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 1.

With A, knit 1 row.

Continue in Garter st (k every row), working 2 rows with B, then 2 rows with A, until Block 2 measures about 13 in. (33 cm) from pick-up row. Bind off.

Place a marker on left side edge of Block 2, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) above pick-up row.

Block 3

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with D, pick up and k51 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 2 between bound-off edge and marker.

Work in Seed st until Block 3 measures about 16 in. (40.5 cm) from pick-up row. Bind off.

Remove marker.

Block 4

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with C, pick up and k80 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 3.

With C, knit 1 row.

Continue in Garter st, working 2 rows with F, then 2 rows with C, until Block 4 measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from pick-up row, end with 2 rows of C as the last 2 rows you work.

Change to F and continue in Garter st until Block 4 measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from pick-up row.

Bind off.

Block 5

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with A, pick up and k101 sts evenly spaced along bound-off edge of Block 1 and right side edge of Block 2.

Work in Seed st until Block 5 measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from pick-up row. Bind off.

Block 6

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with D, pick up and k31 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 5.

With D. knit 1 row.

Continue in Garter st, working 2 rows with F, then 2 rows with D, until Block 6 measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from pick-up row.

Bind off.

Block 7

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with F, pick up and k75 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 6.

Work in Rev St st until Block 7 measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from pick-up row, end with a WS row as the last row you work. Bind off.

Block 8

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with C, pick up and k31 sts evenly spaced along right side edge of Block 5.

Work in Garter st until Block 8 measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from pick-up row, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Bind off.

Block 9

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with E, pick up and k75 sts evenly spaced along right side edge of Block 8.

With E, knit 1 row.

Continue in Garter st, working 2 rows with C, then 2 rows with E, until Block 9 measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from pick-up row. Bind off.

Following diagram, sew left side edge of Block 4 to edges of Blocks 1 and 2. Leave side edges of Block 7 and 9 unsewn.

LOWER LEFT FRONT

Block 10

With E, cast on 75 sts.

Work in Seed st until Block 10 measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to A and work in Garter st, working 2 rows with A, then 2 rows with E, until Block 10 measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Bind off.

Block 11

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with C, pick up and k75 sts evenly spaced along left side edge of Block 10.

Work in Garter st until Block 10 measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from pick-up row, end with a WS row as the last row you work. Bind off.

LOWER RIGHT FRONT

Block 12

With B, cast on 50 sts.

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Work in Rev St st until Block 12 measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Change to A and work in Garter st, working 2 rows with A, then 2 rows with B, until Block 12 measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Bind off.

Block 13

Pick-Up Row (RS): From RS with D, pick up and k75 sts evenly spaced along right side edge of Block 12.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Seed st until Block 13 measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from pick-up row, end with a WS row as the last row you work. Change to F and work in Garter st until Block 13 measures about 14 in. (35.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew pieces together.

Armhole Edging

From RS with circular needle and D, beg at underarm, pick up and k90 sts evenly spaced around edge of one armhole. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with working yarn from the right hand needle.

Knit 5 rnds.

Bind off.

Repeat edging around other armhole.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

Rev St st = Reverse Stockinette stitch

rnd(s) = round(s)


RS = right side


st(s) = stitch(es)

LOWER RIGHT FRONT
