SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

SIZE

About 45 x 55 in. (114.5 x 139.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 176 Peacock 1 ball (A)
 - 117 Electric Blue 1 ball (B)
 - 183 Periwinkle 1 ball (C)
 - 111 Sky Blue 1 ball (D)
 - 115 Light Blue 1 ball (E)
 - 102 Aqua 1 ball (F)
 - 106 Aquamarine 1 ball (G)
 - 169 Pistachio 1 ball (H)
 - 113 Scarlet 1 ball (I)
 - 134 Terracotta 1 ball (J)
 - 112 Raspberry 1 ball (K)
 - 158 Mustard 1 ball (L)
 - 104 Pink Grapefruit 1 ball (M)
 - 101 Pink 1 ball (N)
 - 159 Lemon 1 ball (O)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

16 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-60 of Strip I.
One triangle = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) tall and 15 in. (38 cm) wide.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

w&t (wrap and turn) w&t is a technique used to ensure that a small hole doesn't form at the end of a short row.

1. Bring the yarn between the needles to the front of the work (the front is the side that is facing you). Take care not to wrap the yarn over a needle, this would create a new st.
2. Slip the next st from the left hand needle to the right hand needle as if to purl.
3. Turn the work. After turning, the yarn will be in the back of the work.
4. Bring the yarn between the needles to the front of the work.
5. Slip the first st on left needle as if to purl, back onto right needle. You will now have one stitch on the right needle with a wrap of yarn around the base of the st.
6. Bring the yarn between the needles to the back of the work and continue with the row.
7. When you encounter the wrapped st on the next row, lift the wrap with the tip of your right hand needle and work it tog with the wrapped st.

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NOTES

1. Three Strips are made separately, then sewn together following a diagram to make the Afghan.
2. Each Strip consists of 22 triangles worked using short rows. Short rows are rows that are worked over a portion of the sts in a row, leaving the remaining sts unworked. To work short rows, the pattern instructions will tell you to "w&t" (wrap and turn) before you reach the end of the row.
3. The yarn color is changed at the beginning of each triangle.

STRIP I

With E, cast on 60 sts.

Triangle 1

Rows 1 and 2: Knit.

Row 3 (RS): K56, w&t, leaving last 4 sts unworked.

Row 4 and all even numbered rows: K to end of row.

Row 5: K52, w&t, leaving last 8 sts unworked.

Row 7: K48, w&t, leaving last 12 sts unworked.

Row 9: K44, w&t, leaving last 16 sts unworked.

Row 11: K40, w&t, leaving last 20 sts unworked.

Row 13: K36, w&t, leaving last 24 sts unworked.

Row 15: K32, w&t, leaving last 28 sts unworked.

Row 17: K28, w&t, leaving last 32 sts unworked.

Row 19: K24, w&t, leaving last 36 sts unworked.

Row 21: K20, w&t, leaving last 40 sts unworked.

Row 23: K16, w&t, leaving last 44 sts unworked.

Row 25: K12, w&t, leaving last 48 sts unworked.

Row 27: K8, w&t, leaving last 52 sts unworked.

Row 29: K4, w&t, leaving last 56 sts unworked.

Row 30: K to end of row.

Triangle 2

Change to L.

Row 31 (RS): K to end of row, knitting wraps tog with wrapped sts.

Row 32: K4, w&t, leaving last 56 sts unworked.

Row 33 and all odd numbered rows: K to end of row.

Row 34: K4, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 52 sts unworked.

Row 36: K8, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 48 sts unworked.

Row 38: K12, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 44 sts unworked.

Row 40: K16, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 40 sts unworked.

Row 42: K20, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 36 sts unworked.

Row 44: K24, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 32 sts unworked.

Row 46: K28, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 28 sts unworked.

Row 48: K32, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 24 sts unworked.

Row 50: K36, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 20 sts unworked.

Row 52: K40, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 16 sts unworked.

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Row 54: K44, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 12 sts unworked.

Row 56: K48, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 8 sts unworked.

Row 58: K52, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3, w&t, leaving last 4 sts unworked.

Row 60: K56, k wrapped st and wrap tog, k3.

Triangles 3-22

Rep Rows 1-60 of Triangles 1 and 2 for ten more times to make a total of 22 triangles, changing color at beg of each triangle as follows: Work 1 triangle each with D, K, A, C, N, O, G, B, M, I, F, L, J, H, E, N, K, A, C, and F.

STRIP II

Make same as Strip I, working 1 triangle each with A, C, I, L, M, H, F, B, K, N, D, L, A, G, M, O, J, K, F, E, D, and H.

STRIP III

Make same as Strip I, working 1 triangle each with H, B, L, N, C, I, O, E, D, A, K, M, O, J, G, F, N, H, B, C, O, and M.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew Strips together.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

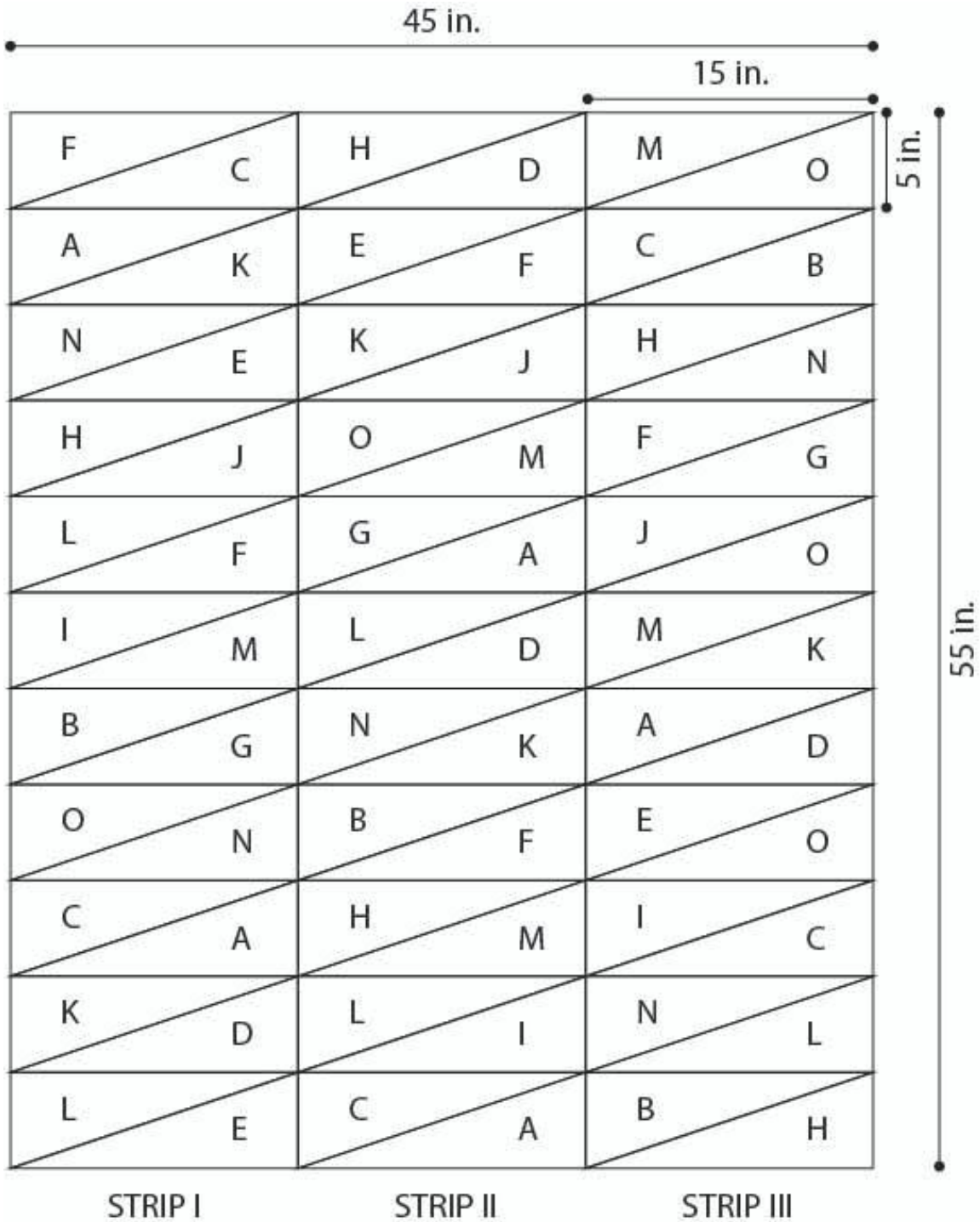
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
