

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand[®] Scarfie[®] Graphic Mitered Wrap

<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Length from back neck to lower point About 32 in. (81.5 cm) **Finished Width** About 64 in. (162.5 cm), at widest

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Scarfie® (Art. #826)
 - 201 Cream/Black 3 balls
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)





<u>GAUGE</u>

1 Mitered Square = about 23 x 23 in. (58.5 x 58.5 cm). 12 dc + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

rev sc (reverse single crochet) Single crochet worked from left to right (right to left, if left-handed). Insert hook into next stitch to the right (left), under loop on hook, and draw up a loop. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

<u>NOTE</u>

Three Squares are worked separately, then crocheted together to make the Wrap.

MITERED SQUARES (make 3)

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Row 1 into the ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ring – you will have 4 dc and a center ch-3 sp in this row. Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring. **Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk next dc, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 6 dc, 2 ch-1 sps and a center ch-3 sp (3 dc and 1 ch-1 sp on each side of center ch-3 sp).

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in each dc to center ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 space, dc in each dc to beg ch-4, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 10 dc, 2 ch-1 sps and a center ch-3 sp (5 dc and 1 ch-1 sp on each side of center ch-3 sp)

Rows 4-6: Rep Row 3 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp in Row 6.

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Row 7: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 - (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp.

Row 8: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp.

Rows 9-28: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in each dc to center ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 43 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp in Row 28.

Row 29: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in each dc to center ch-3 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 43 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp.

Row 30: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, *dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * once more, dc in next dc, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 43 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp.

Rows 31-33: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, *dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * once more, dc in each dc to center ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in center ch-3 sp, **dc in each dc in next ch-1 sp ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from ** once more, dc in next 10 dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – (1 dc, ch 1, 10 dc, ch 1, 43 dc, ch 1, 9 dc) on each side of center ch-3 sp in Row 33.

Row 34 (Mesh Row): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 5 times, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 21 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 4 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 4 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 21 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 21 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc) 5 times, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 35 dc and 34 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-3 sp.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Join Squares

Arrange Squares following diagram, matching ch-1 sps along side edges of neighboring Squares.

From WS, beg at outer edge of Wrap and working through both thicknesses, join yarn in top of first dc at beg of one joining line, **working through both thicknesses, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sl st in next dc; rep from * all the way across edge to join Squares ***, sl st in corner ch-3 sp of one Square, then working

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through both thicknesses, sI st in first dc at beg of next side edges to be joined, rep from ** to ***. Do NOT fasten off.

Border

Turn piece over to work from RS.

Rnd 1 (RS): Working all the way around outside edge of Wrap, ch 1, *rev sc in end of next row or ch-1 sp, ch 2, sk next dc (do not sk next row if working in ends of rows); rep from * all the way around; join with sl st in beg ch-1. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
